WGCA COACHES POLL RANKINGS ANNOUNCED

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (April 30, 2021) – The Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA) has announced the results of the most recent WGCA Coaches Poll. This is the fourth and final poll of the 2021 spring season.

University of South Carolina holds steady at the No. 1 spot in Division I this week, receiving 16 first-place votes, while Duke University stays at No. 2 with the remaining two votes. Wake Forest University and Louisiana State University remain at No. 3 and No. 4, respectively, while Oklahoma State University jumped four spots to round out the top-five.

In Division II, Dallas Baptist University remains No. 1 after receiving all but one first-place vote, while Lynn University holds steady at No. 2 after receiving the remaining vote. Limestone University and University of Indianapolis stay at No. 3 and No. 4, respectively, while Texas A&M University – Commerce climbs two spots to enter the top-five.

University of Redlands holds steady at the top spot in Division III after receiving eight first-place votes, while Methodist University trails by just one point with six first-place votes. George Fox University climbs two spots to No. 3, followed by Carnegie Mellon University at No. 4. Centre College remains in the top-five, with Williams College jumping 15 spots to tie for the No. 5 spot.

In NAIA, Dalton State College moves to the No. 1 spot with all but one first-place vote, while Keiser University drops to No. 2 with the remaining vote. William Carey University trails closely behind to remain at No. 3.
