MIZUNO WGCA COACHES POLL RANKINGS ANNOUNCED

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (May 5, 2023) – The Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA) has announced the results of the most recent Mizuno WGCA Coaches Poll. This is the fourth and final poll of the 2023 spring season.



Stanford University remains atop the Division I rankings, receiving nine first-place votes, while Wake Forest University received the remaining nine votes to trail by just one point. The rest of the top-five also holds steady with Louisiana State University at No. 3, University of South Carolina at No. 4, and Mississippi State University at No. 5.

In Division II, Lynn University continues to hold the top spot after receiving all but one first-place vote, while Dallas Baptist University stays at No. 2 with the remaining vote. University of Findlay remains at No. 3, while Nova Southeastern University moves up one spot to No. 4. Anderson University drops two spots to round out the top-five.

Emory University remains No. 1 in Division III, receiving 12 first-place votes, while University of Redlands holds steady at the No. 2 spot with the remaining three votes. The rest of the top-five remains unchanged, with Washington University in St. Louis and George Fox University coming in at No. 3 and No. 4, respectively, and Carnegie Mellon University at No. 5.

In NAIA, Dalton State College remains the unanimous No. 1, with Keiser University and Oklahoma City University holding steady at No. 2 and No. 3, respectively.
