MIZUNO WGCA COACHES POLL RANKINGS ANNOUNCED

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (October 25, 2024) – The Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA) has announced the results of the most recent Mizuno WGCA Coaches Poll. This is the third poll of the Fall 2024 season.



Stanford University continues to hold the top spot in Division I after receiving 18 first-place votes, while University of Arkansas received three votes to jump seven spots to No. 2. University of South Carolina received four first-place votes and dropped one spot to No. 3, followed by University of Texas who holds steady at No. 4. University of Southern California received one first-place vote to round out the top five.

Anderson University received all but two first-place votes to jump four spots and claim the top spot atop the Division II rankings, while Dallas Baptist University at University of Findlay each received one vote to come in at No. 2 and No. 3, respectively. Wingate University jumps three spots to No. 4, while Flagler College rounds out the top five.

In Division III, Emory University claims the top spot after receiving 16 first-place votes, while Carnegie Mellon University drops one spot to No. 2 with one vote. Washington University in St. Louis received three first-place votes to jump four spots to No. 3, while Pomona-Pitzer and George Fox University come in at No. 4 and No. 5, respectively.

Keiser University holds steady at the top spot in NAIA after receiving all but two first-place votes, while University of British Columbia received the remaining votes to come in at No. 2. SCAD Savannah drops one spot to round out the top three.

The next Mizuno WGCA Coaches Poll will be released on Friday, November 15.
