

Safety & Sanitation Practices

The Wisconsin Chiropractic Association is committed to offering quality education programs in the safest manner possible.

Attendees will be required to follow the safety practices outlined below as a condition of attendance with no exceptions.

Responsibilities of our attendees:

- **Masks are required at WCA in-person events.** Thank you for your cooperation. A mask will be provided if you do not have one.
- **If you are sick, stay home.** If you have an elevated temperature, or a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, stay home.
- If you have been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days, stay home.
- If you have experienced any cold or Flu like symptoms in the last 72 hours, stay home.
- If someone in your house is sick, stay home.
- Traffic should flow in one direction whenever possible. Please adhere to posted guidelines.
- Please make every attempt to maintain social distancing during restroom and lunch breaks, and in all common areas.
- Wash your hands before and after you leave the facility. If it is not possible to wash your hands, use hand sanitizer when you enter and before you leave.

WCA responsibilities:

- Provide a seminar venue that allows for social distancing. Whenever possible, meeting rooms will be set with one attendee per 6' table.
- Hand sanitizer will be available.
- Surfaces will be wiped during breaks whenever possible by venue staff.
- Food and beverage service will be limited. Please plan to bring or purchase meals, coffee and snacks while you are at the seminar.
