



WREA Spotlight on Public Education Initiative for WREA Local Units Round Six—Due by September 30, 2019



The WREA Public Education Outreach Committee launched an initiative in 2014 called the WREA Spotlight on Public Education, to support educators and acknowledge the excellent work and results occurring in public schools. With the continued support of the WREA Foundation, **WREA local units** may apply for a \$100 grant to fund a new project or to enhance an existing project that supports public education. ***Round Six runs from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.***

CRITERIA

1. Does the proposal reflect excellent work and results in local public schools? Yes No
2. Is the proposal non-partisan? Yes No
3. Is the proposal focused on public education? Yes No

Steps Involved

1. Each local unit president and educational issues chair will identify a project team. If there is not a unit public education outreach chair, the president could appoint a public education outreach chair.
2. Determine a project to promote public education.
3. The Project team may visit School District Administrators in their local unit area to discuss the WREA Spotlight on Public Education Initiative.
4. Submit an application by September 30, 2019 to the WREA Office for a new project or an enhancement on a current project. If you previously submitted in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, or 2018 you may submit again for another \$100.
5. Publicize your local project on school district websites and local media.
