Pro Bono & Public Service Scholarships One-Year Paid Membership & Admission to 67th Annual Meeting

▶ Do you perform public service or legal aid litigation in any of the federal courts of the Seventh Circuit?

▶ Have you performed significant *pro bono* work in any of the federal courts of the Seventh Circuit?

If so, the Seventh Circuit Bar Association invites your application for a *Pro Bono & Public Service Scholarship*, covering the cost of a one-year Association membership and the cost of attending the 67th Annual Meeting of the Seventh Circuit Bar Association, April 29 – May 1, 2018, at the Radisson Blu Aqua, Chicago, Illinois (including meeting meals and hotel for out-of-town attendees).

In order to be eligible for consideration, you must have completed one of the following between January 2017 and the present:

- Devoted at least 100 hours to *pro bono* or public service work in one of the courts of the Seventh Circuit; **or**
- Appeared in and disposed of two or more cases through a settlement assistance or other limited representation program; **or**
- Volunteered with a drop-in or *pro se* assistance program at least five times; **or**
- Worked at least three months for a government agency or legal aid provider that does not otherwise cover Association costs.

Scholarships are available for work performed in the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals, or in any of *each* of the District Courts or Bankruptcy Courts within the Seventh Circuit (C.D. Ill., N.D. Ill., S.D. Ill., N.D. Ind., S.D. Ind., E.D. Wisc., and W.D. Wisc.).
