API Usage Policy

June 2019

Subject to the restrictions below, we grant you a non-exclusive, worldwide, non-transferable, limited license to access our APIs and documentation only as necessary to develop, test and support an integration of your application (an "**Application**" or "**App**") with the Services. You may charge for your Application; however, you may not sell, rent, lease, sublicense, redistribute, or syndicate access to any of our APIs. As long as you follow this API Usage Policy, SDPC grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-assignable, non-transferable license to use the APIs to develop, test, and support any software application, website, or product, and to integrate the SDPC APIs with your Application.

Terms of Use

Defining Responsibilities

1. Ensure your app is stable and easily navigable. For example, verify that you have integrated Login correctly.
2. Don't confuse, deceive, defraud, mislead, or harass anyone.
3. Be transparent about your identity and your app's identity.
4. Don't use the API for any app that constitutes, promotes or is used in connection with spyware, adware, or any other malicious programs or code.
5. Don't store or cache API login credentials.
6. Follow any instructions we include in our technical documentation.
7. Provide a publicly accessible privacy policy that tells people what you collect and how you will use this information.
8. Comply with your privacy policy.
9. Remove within 24 hours any User Content or other information that the owner asks you to remove.
10. Don't use API information for anything other than analytics without our prior permission. For example, don't display these relationships in your app.
11. Protect the information you receive from us against unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. For example, don't use data obtained from us to provide tools that are used for surveillance.
12. Don't transfer any data that you receive from us (including anonymous, aggregate, or derived data) to any ad network, data broker, influencer network, or other advertising or monetization-related service.
13. Don't reverse engineer the API
14. Don't sell, lease, or sublicense any data derived through the API.

15. Comply with all applicable laws or regulations. Don't provide or promote content that violates any rights of any person, including but not limited to intellectual property rights, rights of privacy, or rights of personality.
16. You retain your ownership rights in your Application(s) and we own and will continue to own our APIs, documentation and Services, including all related intellectual property rights therein.
17. You may not sell, rent, lease, sublicense, redistribute, or syndicate access to any of our APIs or data received from them. You may leverage the data received to establish value add services and market those to SDPC members.

Setting Expectations

1. The SDPC sets and enforces limits on your use of the APIs (e.g. limiting the number of API requests that you may make or the number of users you may serve), in our sole discretion. You agree to, and will not attempt to circumvent, such limitations documented with each API. If you would like to use any API beyond these limits, you must obtain A4L's express consent.
2. API Availability: The API is accessible 24/7 depending on normal maintenance and upgrading periods.
3. Types of support available and their responsiveness (in high-level terms, not email, 'phone numbers, etc.).
4. Access to developer portal, sandbox environments, refresh of authorities and entitlements (API keys, OAuth client IDs, etc.):
5. API Functionality: You may not use the SDPC API to replicate or compete with core products or services offered by SDPC. You acknowledge and agree that SDPC has or may in the future offer products or services that are similar to your Application, and nothing will prevent SDPC from doing so.

Privacy Policy

We use member-related information for the purposes of administering the A4L Community organization and website and communicating and collaborating with our members. Members' interactions with the private site are authenticated. Consequently, we have the capability to identify users and their activities within the site. This information will not be disclosed to any third party for any purpose, except where mandated by law.

1. By requesting membership / guest access and a password you are automatically added to our newsletter mailing list and your identity is available to all Community Board Members upon request.
2. We monitor membership and communicate with members frequently and announce their membership to the public at large.

3. We will strive to inform members, prior to the release of any information concerning them or the organization they represent.

Cookie Policy

Cookies are an essential part of how our site works. Some of these cookies are required by our site to enable you to transact whilst other cookies enable us to give you an enhanced, personalized web experience. By using our site, you also consent to the use of these cookies.

The information stored in cookies is safe and anonymous. They do not contain any information which could personally identify you and your account security is never compromised. The A4L Community uses cookies to ensure that we provide the best possible online experience. However, as part of our privacy and cookie policy, we require your consent to use them.

To withdraw your consent, or if you want to be notified each time a cookie is about to be used, you should amend the settings provided in your web browser to prevent us from storing cookies on your computer's hard drive.
