NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING

The Asian American Bar Association of New York (“AABANY”) Annual Meeting of Members (“Annual Meeting”) will be held on **February 11, 2026** at **7:00 pm** at King & Spalding, located at 1290 Avenue of the Americas (Sixth Avenue), New York, NY 10104.

At the Annual Meeting, there are two proposals scheduled to be voted on:

- Proposal 1 – To elect the officers identified on the attached proxy to serve a one-year term for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2026 and ending March 31, 2027 (the “2027 Fiscal Year”); and
- Proposal 2 – To elect 11 directors from the 11 nominees identified on the attached proxy to serve two-year terms beginning on the first day of the 2027 Fiscal Year.

Every Active Member (as defined in AABANY’s by-laws) in good standing (as defined in AABANY’s by-laws) as of **January 5, 2026** shall be entitled to vote at the Annual Meeting.

Your vote is very important. Whether or not you plan to attend the Annual Meeting, we encourage you to **complete and return the attached proxy as soon as possible.**

Your attendance at the Annual Meeting in person will not cause your previously granted Proxy to be revoked unless you specifically so request.
