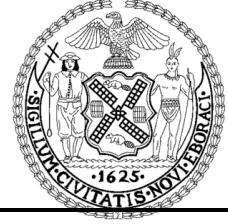

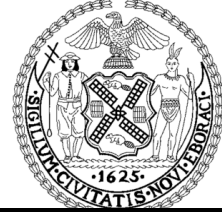

Bus Transportation to Select Overnight Shelter Locations

The below transportation to shelters is available as long as space is available. Public transportation is also available to shelter locations.

Staten Island

For transportation to: Tottenville High School, 100 Luten Avenue between Deisius and Billiou Streets, one bus pickup starts at Hylan Boulevard at Richmond Avenue. A second bus starts pickups at Mill Road and New Dorp Lane, making pickups along Mill all the way to Guyon Avenue.

For transportation to Susan Wagner High School, 1200 Manor Road and Brielle avenue, bus pickup starts at Hylan Boulevard and New Dorp Lane and makes stops along Hylan all the way to Steuben Street.

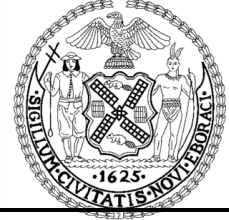

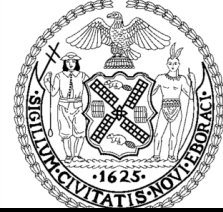

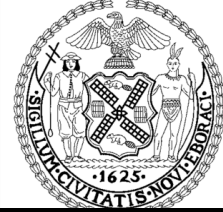
With the drop in temperatures, the City is providing warming centers located within Senior Centers in the five boroughs for a place to get out of the cold during the day. Please see times and locations below.

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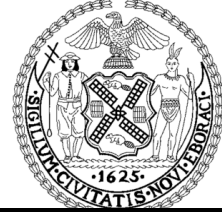

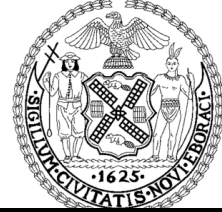

You must be unemployed prior to or as a direct result of Hurricane Sandy.

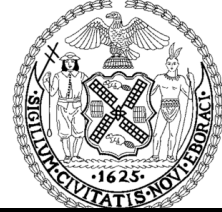

Small Business Services & Economic Development Corporation

New York City, including the New York City Department of Small Business Services (SBS) and The New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYEDC) is coordinating a set of services to help New York businesses in

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recovering from the effects of Hurricane Sandy. Below is an outline of available assistance and how you can access them.

If you need financial assistance:

Get help with the Emergency Loan Fund

The City of New York and Goldman Sachs are providing \$10 million in emergency loans to help New York City businesses damaged by Hurricane Sandy. NYC Business Solutions and the New York Business Development Corporation (NYBDC) will administer the loan program. If you are a small business in need of an emergency loan to recover from business interruption, you can now access loans up to \$25,000. Loans are interest-free for the first six months and 1% interest for the following 24 months. Access Federal Aid Programs for Disaster Recovery

Businesses and private non-profit organizations of any size may borrow up to \$2 million to repair or replace disaster-related damaged or destroyed real estate, machinery and equipment, inventory, and other business assets. Apply for sales tax exemptions of up to \$100,000 for rebuilding materials and equipment

The New York City Industrial Development Agency will provide emergency assistance to small businesses by establishing the Hurricane Emergency Sales Tax Exemption Program ("HESTEP"). This program will provide sales tax exemptions of up to \$100,000 for each affected company on purchases of building, construction and renovation materials, machinery and equipment and other items of personal property and related services needed to rebuild after the storm. Companies undertaking projects of approximately \$350,000 in value or more are encouraged to apply. 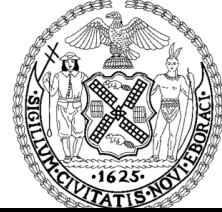
If you are in danger of laying off employees due to Hurricane Sandy:

Enter employees into The Shared Work Program

The Shared Work program gives you an alternative to laying off full-time employees when you have to deal with temporary business downturns. It makes sense for you to keep productive employees. Instead of cutting staff, you can reduce the number of hours of all employees or just a select group, and the employees would receive Shared Work Benefits to help offset the lower wages. **Apply today**: <http://www.labor.ny.gov/ui/employerinfo/shared-work-program.shtm>.

Help employees get Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA)

Disaster Unemployment Assistance is a Federal program that can provide payments to people who have lost work or income due to Hurricane Sandy. The NYS Department of Labor determines if claims filed under the program are valid, and makes payments to those who qualify. Laid-off employees should apply for DUA by December 3, 2012. Apply

If you need help with business interruption:

Take steps that can help reduce and recover your losses

- If you have access to your building, gather employee and supplier contact information, legal, insurance and financial records
- Lock your facility
- Document your losses and take high-quality photos of damages to the structure and your inventory
- Contact your insurance company
- Try to assess value of each item, with invoices and receipts where possible
- Discard perishable/dangerous items after documenting them
- Keep everything else to show to insurance companies
- Keep invoices or receipts if you are repairing the damages
- Contact your customers, your employees, and your suppliers
- Collect any logs of business decisions, communications, and correspondence you have

If you need on-site assistance, the SBS Business Outreach is currently on-call for any storm-related business inquiries and is closely coordinating with the NYC Office of Emergency Management. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) / Food Stamps

If you are currently receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits in New York City and have been affected by Hurricane Sandy, you are eligible to automatically receive replacement benefits of up to 50% of your allotment for spoiled food due to power outages and floods. You will not need to apply, however, you must be a current food stamp client as of October 31 and live in an area of the City affected by the storm to qualify for this replacement benefit.

The areas in New York City that will receive automatic replacement benefits include severely affected areas where flooding and power outages occurred, such as the Rockaways, Staten Island and Lower Manhattan. For a list of eligible zipcodes, visit HRA's website at NYC.gov. Additional zip codes in New York City that experienced extended power loss may be added as more details about the number of households affected become available.

If you are eligible, replacement benefits will be placed onto your EBT card during the week of November 5, 2012. Because your replacement benefits will be put on your EBT card automatically, you do not need to travel to apply at a local Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program office for this benefit.

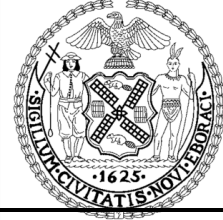
You may also apply for up to the full allotment of your monthly grant if you are eligible and meet the following criteria:

- You must have an active SNAP case by October 31;
- The food you lost must have been purchased with SNAP benefits;
- You must have lived in an affected area and had power outages or flooding caused by Hurricane Sandy;
- You must complete and sign appropriate paperwork explaining your loss within 10 days of you reporting the loss.

You will need to verify you live in a storm-affected area. HRA will review your request and if approved, benefits will be issued to you through your Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card. The application can be downloaded at http://www.nyc.gov/html/hra/downloads/pdf/snap_form_2291a.pdf and faxed, mailed or dropped off at an HRA office. For more information, call 311.

Effective immediately, food stamp SNAP benefits can be used to purchase hot and prepared foods at already approved retailers that accept EBT cards throughout New York City. Hot and prepared foods purchases are not usually permitted under the United States Department of Agriculture guidelines, however, a federal waiver was given to allow this in order to help recipients in storm-affected areas with no ability to refrigerate or cook. The waiver will be in effect through November 30.

For food stamp SNAP benefits recertification that are scheduled to expire 10/31, it is expected that they will be extended through November 28.

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

FEMA Application Information

Disaster assistance is financial or direct assistance to individuals and families whose property has been damaged or destroyed as a result of a federally-declared disaster, and whose losses are not covered by insurance. It is meant to help you with critical expenses that cannot be covered in other ways. This assistance is not intended to restore your damaged property to its condition before the disaster.

While some housing assistance funds are available through our Individuals and Households Program, most disaster assistance from the Federal government is in the form of loans administered by the Small Business Administration. Additional forms of assistance offered by the Federal government can be found on DisasterAssistance.gov.

First, your losses must have occurred in an area covered by a disaster declaration.

Second, you need to apply to FEMA in one of three ways:

- **Online:** DisasterAssistance.gov
- **Smartphone:** m.fema.gov
- **Phone:** 1-800-621-3362 (TTY: 1-800-462-7585 for people with speech or hearing disabilities)

*Please note that if you have insurance, you must also file a claim with your insurance company.

You will need the following information to complete the registration:

Social Security Number

You will be asked to provide your social security number. If you are undocumented, you will not be personally eligible for FEMA cash assistance programs (Individuals and Households Program Assistance). However, your household may still be eligible to receive assistance as you may apply on behalf of your U.S. citizen child, or another adult household member may qualify the household for assistance.

(NOTE: If you, your co-applicant or a minor child in the household are a U.S. Citizen, Non-Citizen National, or a Qualified Alien and **do not** have a social security number, FEMA will not be able to complete a registration. The Social Security number is required for Identity Verification purposes.)

If you are registering for a business, enter the social security number of the responsible party for the business, the social security number will be used for an identifier only.

If you are in need of further explanation/information call FEMA Helpline at (1-800-621-3362).

Insurance information

You will be asked to identify the type(s) of insurance coverage you have.

Financial information

You will be asked to enter your family's gross total household income at the time of the disaster.

Contact information

Along with the address and phone number where the damages occurred, you will be asked for information on how FEMA can contact you. It is very important that you provide FEMA with your current mailing address and phone numbers where you can be contacted.

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Direct Deposit Information (optional)

If you are determined to be eligible for assistance and would prefer that funds be transferred to your account, you will be asked for your banking information, which includes; the institution name, type of account, routing and account number.

Please have pen and paper available to record information during the registration process.



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Cora Brown Fund

This unique fund directs payments to individuals and groups for disaster-related needs that have not been or will not be met by government agencies or other organizations.

Crisis Counseling

This program provides grants that enable states to offer immediate crisis counseling services, when required, to victims of a major federally declared disaster for the purpose of relieving mental health problems caused or aggravated by a major disaster or its aftermath. Assistance is short-term and community-oriented.

Hazard Mitigation Grants

The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) provides grants to states to implement mitigation measures after recovery from a disaster and to provide funding for previously identified mitigation measures to benefit the area.

In certain cases, individuals who have no work history or are unable to work may also be eligible for DUA benefits.

Physical Disaster Loans—Residential SBA Disaster Loans Available to Homeowners and Renters

SBA's Home Disaster Loan Program falls into two categories: personal property loans and real property loans. These loans cover only uninsured or underinsured property and primary residences. Loan maturities may be up to 30 years.

Personal Property Loans

A personal property loan provides a creditworthy homeowner or renter with up to \$40,000 to repair or replace personal property items, such as furniture, clothing, or automobiles, damaged or lost in a disaster.

Real Property Loans

A creditworthy homeowner may apply for a "real property loan" of up to \$200,000 to repair or restore the homeowner's primary residence to its pre-disaster condition.

Physical Disaster Loans—Businesses

This program provides loans to small and large businesses in declared disaster areas for uninsured physical damage and losses. The maximum loan amount is \$2 million.

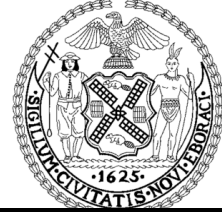
Tax Relief

Individuals and businesses located in areas included in major disaster declarations are allowed extra time (four years for homes and two years for business property) to replace property due to involuntary conversion (e.g., destruction from wind or floods, theft, or property ordered to be demolished). Casualty losses can also be deducted against income in the prior tax year, and certain disaster relief grants are not taxable.

This tax relief is automatic for affected taxpayers whose address of record is in the Federally declared disaster area. All other affected taxpayers must self identify for disaster relief by contacting the IRS at 1-866-562-5227. Social Security Administration
