**Prisca Bae, Chief Partnerships Officer of The Asian American Foundation**

The AABANY Women’s Leadership Award is presented to individuals who have demonstrated exceptional leadership and achievement in supporting and promoting the interests of women. Ms. Bae has consistently supported and made significant impacts for women, girls, and communities of color throughout her career. She has also worked tirelessly for The Asian American Foundation (TAAF) to support AAPI communities across the United States.

Ms. Bae joined TAAF from the private sector where she designed and launched philanthropic and social impact initiatives centered around helping women and communities of color. She was the Senior Director at PepsiCo, where she oversaw the gender diversity and women’s strategy for the Global Diversity & Engagement Center of Excellence; the Vice President of Seneca Women, an advisory firm founded by former U.S. Ambassador for Global Women’s Issue, Melanne Verveer; an inaugural Director of the Women in the World Foundation; and during her time at Goldman Sachs, managed Goldman Sachs Gives, a billion dollar charitable fund for its partners.

Ms. Bae currently serves on the boards of The Roger Lehecka Double Discovery Center at Columbia University, the Korean American Community Foundation and The Li.st, a community of high impact women in media, business and tech.
