**ASIAN AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION OF NEW YORK CONGRATULATES
JUSTICE JEFFERY K. OING ON BEING SELECTED AS AN HONOREE BY THE
NEW YORK COUNTY LAWYERS ASSOCIATION AT ITS ANNUAL LAW DAY
LUNCHEON**

NEW YORK – May 17, 2019 – The Asian American Bar Association of New York (“AABANY”) is proud to announce that Justice Jeffrey K. Oing, Appellate Division, First Department of the New York State Supreme Court, was honored by the New York County Lawyers Association at its Annual Law Day Luncheon on May 17, 2019, held at Battery Gardens in Downtown Manhattan. Justice Oing will be honored for his exceptional achievements and dedication to public service.

Justice Oing began his legal career in 1989 as a law clerk to Chief Justice Robert N. Wilentz of the Supreme Court of New Jersey. In 1990, he joined the firm of Donovan Leisure Newton & Irvine as a litigation associate. He briefly served as assistant counsel to the Governor of New Jersey in 1992, before joining the firm of Herold and Haines, where he worked as a litigation associate until 1993.

From 1993 to 2002, Justice Oing held various positions in the NYS Supreme Court, including principal court attorney for the NYS Supreme Court's Law Department (1993-95), court attorney for Supreme Court Justice Marilyn G. Diamond (1995-98), Principal Appellate Court Attorney for the First Department (1998-2000), and court attorney to Supreme Court Justice Walter Tolub (2000-02). In 2002 and 2003, he was the deputy director of the New York City Districting Commission.

Justice Oing's judicial career began in 2004 when he was elected to the New York City Civil Court. In 2009, he was appointed the supervising judge of this court and an acting justice of the Supreme Court. In 2017, Justice Oing was appointed the Appellate Division, First Department of the New York State Supreme Court by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo.

“We commend the New York County Lawyers Association for recognizing Justice Oing’s dedication to public service and his many accomplishments as a lawyer, public servant and

jurist,” states Executive Director Yang Chen. “Justice Oing’s legal career spans over twenty-five years, during which he has been a trailblazer in the Asian American community and has inspired future generations of lawyers and judges. We are proud to count Justice Oing among our most prominent members and are thankful for his dedicated commitment to AABANY’s mission to promote and advance diversity and inclusion in the profession and the judiciary.”
