

## District Additional Assistance (DAA) Funding for FY 2020 Through FY 2023 As Provided in HB2749

- First, always remember that DAA funding is based upon prior year student counts
- Districts that have a student count of less than 1100 are exempt from any cuts and get the full DAA formula funding
- The cuts for FY2020-FY2023 are as follows

Fiscal Year	Cuts
Current Year (FY2019)	\$257,469,900
FY2020	\$128,734,900
FY2021	\$128,734,900
FY2022	\$64,367,400
FY 2023 and Beyond	-0-

This means the level of cuts for FY2020 and FY2021 will be the same

- The Department of Education can not calculate the exact cut for each district until the district budgets are submitted to the ADE. However, since we have Anabel Aportela, Director of Research for AASBO & ASBA, we have the ability to do a rough estimate of the FY2020 cut. We estimate the cut to be approximately 35%. For example, if your DAA formula amount was \$100 your DAA cut would be \$35. Remember this 35% estimate for the cut is just an estimate.
- The reduction for FY2022 is reduced to \$64,367,400 and then the cut is \$0 starting in FY 2023.
