He currently serves as the Addictionologist for three centers in the Los Angeles area, including the Klean Center in West Hollywood, California. Dr. Honzel evaluates health professionals for substance use disorders for their respective licensing boards in California. He serves on California's State Bar Diversion Evaluation Committee and has worked toward the reinstatement of a Diversion Program for physicians in California.
