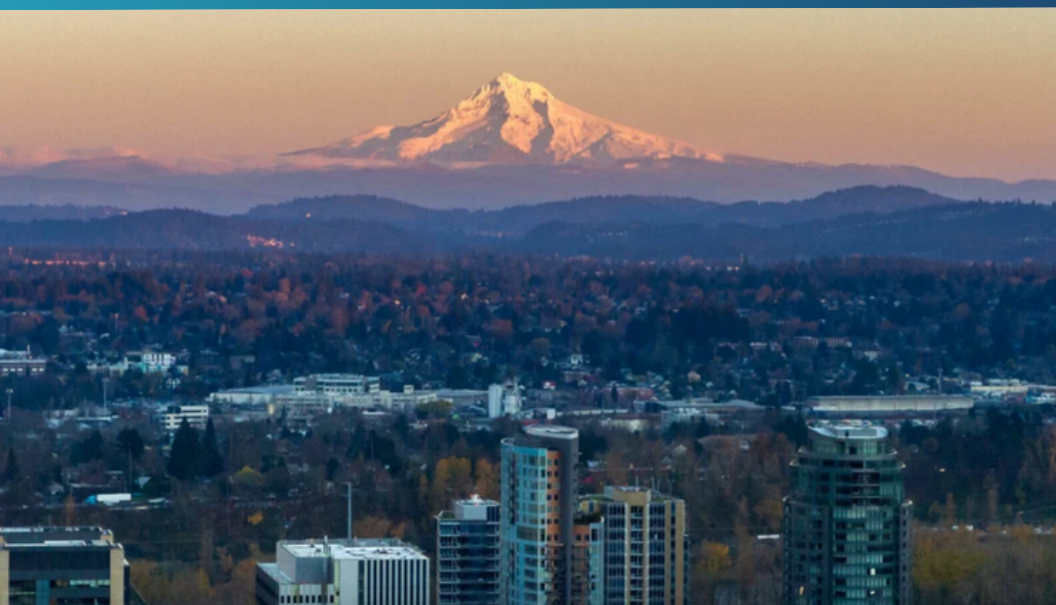

HILTON PORTLAND DOWNTOWN

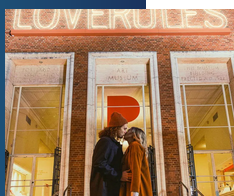
THINGS TO DO IN PORTLAND

Portland offers a variety of activities, diverse locations to explore, and unique experiences. Below are some attractions in Portland, each showcasing a deep respect for the world and providing diverse ways to embrace cultures.



> WASHINGTON PARK

Washington Park is one of Portland's main attractions. This 410-acre park is home to the Oregon Zoo, the Portland Japanese Garden, World Forestry Center, Hoyt Arboretum, and International Rose Test Garden. > PORTLAND ART MUSEUM

Founded in 1892, the Portland Art Museum is one of the oldest art museums in the United States. Alongside their permanent collection, they hold unique exhibitions that celebrate different cultures and bring Oregon and the world closer together.



> WATERFRONT BLUES FESTIVAL

The Waterfront Blues Festival is the largest and longest-running music festival in Portland. Started in 1988, the Waterfront Blues Festival showcases local Portland talent and has raised over \$10 million dollars for local community organizations. > PORTLAND MERCADO

The Portland Mercado is a cornerstone of Latino culture in Portland. 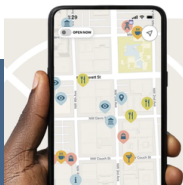

GETTING AROUND

Download the official Portland app to explore like a local — this map-based guide will help you find Portland events, food carts, restaurants, bars, attractions, stores and hidden spots.



> A CITY OF NEIGHBORHOODS

Portland's six main geographical sections (North, Northeast, Northwest, South, Southeast and Southwest) are referred to by residents as the city's "quadrants." The city is divided into north and south by Burnside Street and into east and west by the Willamette River.

Portland actually has more than 90 formally recognized neighborhoods with distinct boundaries. Take a look at the highlighted neighborhood and street guides below, which highlight some of the best places to explore as a visitor to the city, where many restaurants and shops are consolidated.

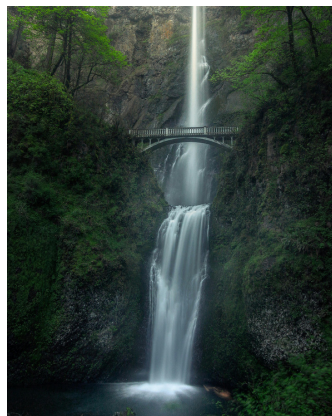
