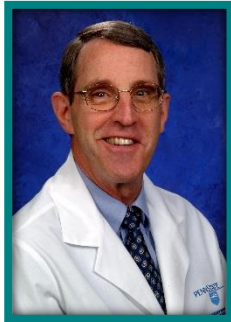
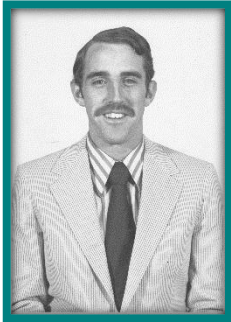

**First SUR Meeting:** 1983 San Francisco

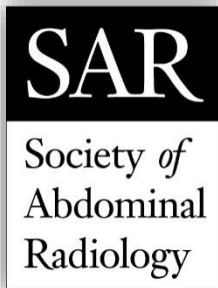
