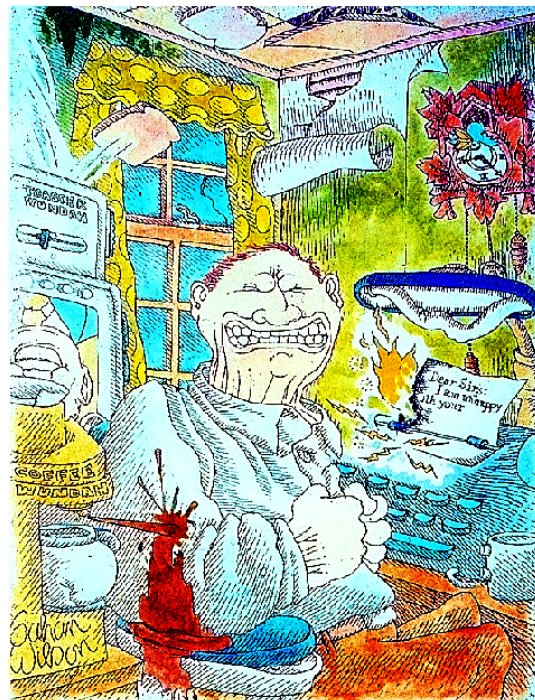
You say it's too difficult!
