Information about the Payroll Tax Presidential Memorandum

Advocates with our ACEC National office in Washington D.C. have been extremely active in the development of the Payroll Protection Program (PPP). Recently, the Administration put forth a [presidential memorandum](#) on payroll tax deferral. Our National office would like to share the following information on that [presidential memorandum](#) on payroll tax deferral:

- The IRS is working on guidance as fast as possible – it could be released this week or next.
- The two biggest issues are whether the payroll tax deferral is mandatory or optional, and what is the liability for employers if the tax is not withheld from employee paychecks and not ultimately forgiven. The guidance will cover additional issues, including calculations.
- Secretary Mnuchin said publicly that the payroll tax deferral will be optional – it's important for the guidance to confirm that.
- Employers would need to consider what to do if an employee leaves between September 1st and December 31st, and the tax obligation is not forgiven.
- It's unclear how the presidential memorandum interacts with relevant state laws.

The key message right now is **to wait for guidance before making any decisions**. If your employees raise questions, it's best to say that the memorandum is under review and the firm must wait to make decisions until guidance has been issued.
