

### **Academy New Scholar Award**

The Academy New Scholar Award recognizes outstanding scholarly contributions to the student of crime and/or criminal justice by someone who has received their most recent doctoral degree within the past six years. Scholarly contributions include, but are not limited to, books, articles, book chapters, reviews, technical reports, grants, or papers to scholarly associations.

To be eligible for this award, the person must be nominated by at least one other member of the Academy and must submit a current vita for review. In addition, the applicant at the time of nomination must be a current member of ACJS and an untenured faculty member.

To apply, submit to the Academy New Scholar Award Chair the following:

1. Nomination(s) by current ACJS member(s).
2. Current vita.
3. Up to four works (articles, book, etc., as described above) for review by the Committee.
