ACVP bylaws Article III, Section 1(d): Emeritus Member: Any Member who has retired from the financially gainful practice of veterinary pathology may request Council designate such Member an Emeritus Member which may be granted by the majority vote of Council. Emeritus Members shall be exempt from the payment of dues. Emeritus Members shall have all privileges of membership, except the right to hold office as an officer or Councilor. Emeritus Members are not required to maintain current Certification status.
