

## Walking from the Hyatt to the Greater Columbus Convention Center

- It's about a 5 to 7-minute walk indoors and about a 12-minute walk outside.
- The GCCC has overhead digital signage and floor maps to help guide you.
- The ADED Registration is adjacent to the Greater Columbus Convention Center's North Entrance on Goodale Blvd.
- The Hyatt and Convention Center are physically connected, so you won't need to step outside at all. The entire route is climate-controlled and fully accessible.

### Indoor Walking Directions

1. From the Hyatt Regency hotel lobby, take the escalators or elevators up one level to access the second-floor Connector to Greater Columbus Convention Center.
2. Follow the enclosed Connector into the Greater Columbus Convention Center (GCCC).
3. Take a Left and follow the path to the escalator or elevator to GCCC concourse.
4. You'll enter the GCCC near the Starbucks.
5. Continue walking north through the Convention Center concourse, past the Meeting Rooms and Exhibit Halls (look for directional signs to "North" or "Pod B/C/D").
6. Keep following signs for the "Short North Ballroom", "Pod D", or "Goodale Street/North Entrance."
7. You will pass several meeting room pods and exhibit halls — stay on the main central concourse.
8. At the end of the concourse, you'll reach a glass atrium area leading to Goodale Blvd. This is the North Entrance.

### Outdoor Walking Directions



1. Exit the hotel onto **North High Street** and turn **right** (northbound).
2. Continue straight along **North High Street** for about 3 blocks.
3. At **Goodale Blvd**, turn **right (east)**.
4. The **North Entrance** will be directly ahead on your right side. This is the entrance facing **Goodale Boulevard**.
5. Follow posted wayfinding signs inside the center for convention for Hall D.
