Site: The St. Scholastica's Mission Hospital, Pambujan Northern Samar, Philippines
Using one dental chair and one fully equipped mobile truck.

Number of Dentists: 7
Number of Physicians: 2
Number of Dental Assistants: 4
Number of Nurses: 14

1. Day started with prayer and blessing from Sister Amadea at 9:00 am on the April 28, 2016 .
2. Patients then issued numbers to determine their position on the line of patients to be seen.
3. Medical evaluation by the nurses and the two physicians. Those deemed qualified for dental work were then referred to the dentists.
4. After seeing the dentist depending on need, patients were then sent to the pharmacy unit for post op medications.
5. Follow-up appointments with the hospital dentists for those needing it were given.
