### CALL FOR WORKSHOPS

The 2019 Annual Conference of the Agricultural Economics Association of South Africa (AEASA) will be hosted by the Free State Branch from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at Ilanga Estate in Bloemfontein. The theme of this year's Conference is "**Growing a Sustainable and Resilient Agriculture**". The conference invites us to address contemporary challenges within South African Agriculture. The Local Organising Committee (LOC) would like to invite proposals to host workshops at the conference.

Prospective hosts should submit a proposal to the LOC by emailing their proposals to [AEASA2019@ufs.ac.za](mailto:AEASA2019@ufs.ac.za) before or on 14 June 2019. Proposal should contain the following:

- A short title that clearly describes the theme of the session.
- Full contact information for the organiser.
- A brief description of the proposed workshop indicating the motivation and purpose.
- Preliminary program indicating potential speakers and their affiliations.

A maximum of three workshops will be hosted during the conference on 10 October 2019. The selection committee's review will result in a proposal being (1) accepted, or (2) rejected. The result of the selection process will be circulated by 1 July 2019.
