In 2018 **134** Chamberlain Scholars attended the AFP International Fundraising Conference in New Orleans, LA.

Since the program began in the year 2000, we have awarded **2,263** Chamberlain Scholarships.

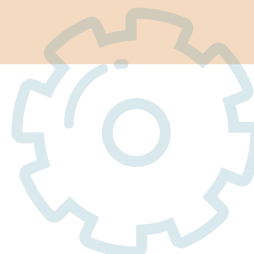
## Diversity Scholarship Program

In 2018, **23** Diversity Scholars attended the AFP International Fundraising Conference. Since the program began in 2012 a total of **107** scholarships have been granted.

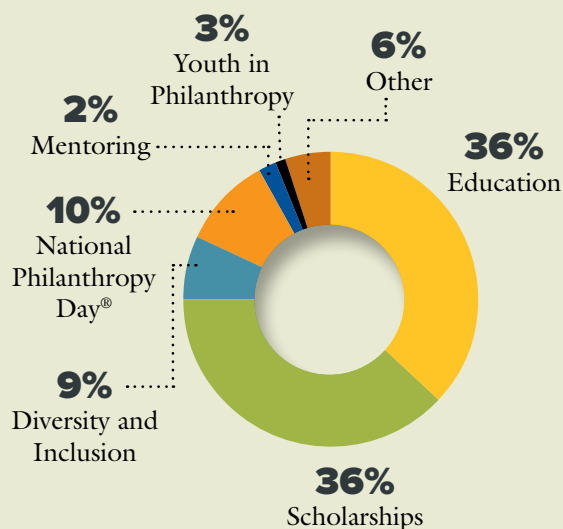




## Chapter Partnership Grants

In partnership with AFP Chapters, the AFP Foundation conducts the **BE the CAUSE** annual fundraising campaign. A portion of the funds raised are granted back to chapters for programs and services in local communities.

In 2018, the Foundation has granted **\$100,828** back to **137** AFP Chapters. These funds were used for the following purposes.



## Leadership Academy

Through the AFP Leadership Academy, sponsored by the AFP Foundation for Philanthropy, relevant training is provided on leadership development for fundraising professionals. Both to lead an AFP chapter, but more importantly to develop leadership skills for the nonprofit sector.

The AFP Foundation has provided **43** scholarships to attend the AFP Leadership Academy since 2014, with **15** scholarships this year.



## Collegiate Scholarship Program

Through the generosity of the Marjorie K. and Stephen M. Levy Philanthropic Professional Education Fund and the AFP Foundation **72** collegiate members have received scholarships to attend the AFP International Fundraising Conference. In 2018, **11** scholarships were granted.
