

# AIA WESTERN MOUNTAIN REGION DESIGN AWARDS CALL FOR ENTRIES, SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS, AND FORMS

The 2019 WMR Conference and the WMR Design Awards are being hosted by AIA Wyoming

September 19-21, 2019 - Snow King Resort, Jackson, WY

The AIA Western Mountain Region Design Awards program recognizes excellence in design, planning and construction of projects located anywhere in the world that are designed by AIA architects, registered and licensed in the Western Mountain Region. Entries from multi-office firms are limited to work designed in the office located in any one of the six states in the Western Mountain Region: Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, Utah and Wyoming.

The intent of the design awards program is to honor the highest standards of design in response to user requirements, site, context, climate and environment. Each entry, regardless of size or classification, is judged individually on the basis of total design merit.

#### **AWARDS TIMELINE**

- April 15 May 24: Call for Entries
- May 24: Deadline for Entry Forms and Fees
- June 21: Design Submittals Due
- Week of July 8: Jury Meets
- First Week of August: Winners Notified
- September 20: WMR Design and Honor Awards Celebration

#### **ENTRY FEE**

\$225 per entry (no late submittals will be accepted)

Entry fees are non-refundable. No exceptions. Make **checks payable to AIA Wyoming**. Visa, MasterCard, Discover accepted.

#### **CATEGORIES**

**Distinguished Building Awards**: Recognizes significant achievements in the planning, design and execution of recently **built** projects.

**Unbuilt Design Awards**: Recognizes achievements in architectural design for commissioned projects that may or may not be built. Student projects and non-building work such as industrial or graphic design may not be submitted. Projects must have been commissioned by a client and may include competition entries, urban design schemes, and similar work.



#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Any work of architecture completed since January 1, 2013, regardless of location, may be entered with the stipulation that the architecture was directed and substantially executed by design professionals and/or firms that are members of the AIA Western Mountain Region. Only the "firm of record" or in its absence, the "architect of record" may submit entries for this competition. When the architect is not the sole author, all other participants substantially contributing to the design of the project must be given credit.

#### **PUBLICITY**

All photography submitted for publicity purposes must be free of restrictions.

#### **AWARDS**

The type and number of awards given will be determined by the jury and may include Honor, Merit and/or Citation. Award winners will be announced and will receive certificates during the AIA Western Mountain Region 2019 Design Awards Presentation on Friday, September 20, 2019 at Snow King Resort in Jackson, WY. Award recipients will be featured throughout 2019 on the AIA Western Mountain Region website, www.aiawmr.org. In recognition of the vital part they play in the creation of these projects, the owners and all members of the design team are invited to attend the awards presentation. If you are submitting a project, please contact the owners and members of the design team and invite them to attend the Awards Celebration as well.

#### 2019 WMR DESIGN AWARDS JURY

If you submit a project, the following applies for entrants and jurors within each individual program.

- Any project that credits any 2019 jury member or his or her firm as architect, associate architect, consultant or client is ineligible and will be disqualified if submitted.
- Communication with any jury member by the entrants is inadmissible and cause for disqualification.
- All architects of award-winning projects will be required to verify that neither they nor any persons
  acting on their behalf had any type of communication with any 2019 jury member regarding a
  submitted project.
- At the jurors' discretion, recognition will be given for Honor, Merit, and Citation levels.

Award recipients will be announced at the WMR Design Awards Celebration, to be held as part of the 2019 WMR Conference. The Awards Celebration will be held at Snow King Resort in Jackson, WY at 7:00 pm on Friday, September 20, 2019.

#### 1. Entry Forms and Fees:

Duplicate as necessary for each project you plan to enter (one payment form can be used for all projects submitted.)
- Complete the Entry Form(s) for each project you plan to enter. Payment in full for all projects can be entered on the Payment Form. Checks must be made payable to AIA Wyoming.

#### 2. Submittal Package

- Submittals for 2019 are required to be digital and in a PC format. All images are to be submitted as JPG files in a PowerPoint presentation uploaded to Dropbox (<a href="https://tinyurl.com/aiawmr2019">https://tinyurl.com/aiawmr2019</a>) as packaged .zip folder.
- The PowerPoint file size for each project submitted must not exceed 20 MB.
- A maximum of 20 PowerPoint slides showing exterior and interior views of the project, site context, site plan(s) and floor plan(s) are required and must be included within the 20 slides. NO SLIDE TRANSITIONS WILL BE ALLOWED.

- No identification of the submitting architect or firm may be included on any part of the submittal, except the identification sheet. If this information is found on any of the PowerPoint slides, the submittal will be disqualified. Use only your project number provided by the AIA WMR Awards team.

# 2019 WMR DESIGN AWARDS INTERN COMPENSATION DISCLAIMER

At a National AIA Board of Directors Meeting on May 3-4, 1995, a policy was adopted:

"Any architect desiring to promote or be promoted by the AIA through awards programs, publications, speaking engagements, elected or appointed office, or admission to Fellowship, must declare that they themselves and/or their firm does not employ unpaid intern architects in their professional practice."

At a Council Meeting of the Western Mountain Region/AIA meeting on May 10, 1996, a policy was adopted:

"Any architect desiring to promote or be promoted by the AIA/Western Mountain Region through awards programs, publications, speaking engagements, elected or appointed office, or admission to Fellowship, must declare that he/she or his/her firm does not employ unpaid interns in their professional practice, an intern being defined as an architecture graduate prior to licensure, a working architecture student, or an architecture student working for credit."
