The Wyoming State Board of Architects and Landscape Architects us under the Department of Administration and Information in name only.

The Board is autonomous in regard to how it operates, budgets, and funds its operation.

All fees generated are deposited to a Special Use fund within the Treasurer's Office which is used only by the Board to fund its operation.

One half of the interest earned on the fund is returned to the Board, the other half is transferred to the Attorney General's Office to pay for our legal counsel.

Other than the half of the interest, no other money is reverted to the general fund.

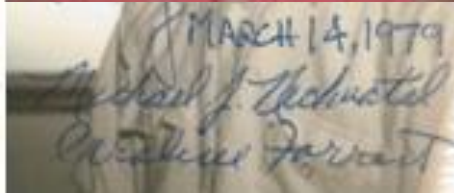
The Board is made up of 5 members;

Complaint and Disciplinary Issues

To date in 2011:

1 consumer complaint was filed against an architect. The complaint was dismissed for lack of clear and convincing evidence of a violation of the laws or rules.

2 applicants for license were denied as not meeting the reciprocal licensing requirement. Both applications were for architecture.

1 board initiated complaint is still under investigation.

In 2010:

1 consumer complaint was filed against an architect. The complaint was dismissed for lack of clear and convincing evidence of a violation of the laws or rules.

3 applications for license were denied as not meeting the reciprocal licensing requirement, 2 architects and 1 LA.
