CRITERIA

The AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee along with SH ARCHITECTURE will offer one (1) scholarship for use in the 2015 Fall Semester at UNLV School of Architecture. This scholarship is in the amount of \$2,000.

The SH ARCHITECTURE SCHOLARSHIP has been established to promote leadership in your Community and in the Profession through commitment and design. Recipients must have demonstrated experience in all three levels of leadership for eligibility.

Criteria for Selection:

- Architecture students currently enrolled in 3rd year with full-time standing (12 credits) and entering 4th year for the 2015 Fall semester at UNLV School of Architecture.
- Good academic standing with a minimum B-Grade point average (3.0 or higher cumulative GPA) is required for Design Studio Courses.
- Candidate must provide an essay describing the applicant's leadership skills in each of the following areas:
 - Leadership/involvement in a local community-based group for at least one year. This can be a religious group, Boy/Girl Scouts, Boys/Girls Clubs/Big Sister/Big Brothers or any other non-profit community organization.
 - Leadership/involvement in the profession such as participation in the AIAS Chapter or other professional organizations. Please include any board positions held, dates and responsibilities.
 - Leadership in design, by providing examples or portfolio of projects evidencing design skills. Examples of previous academic projects or personal work which can be architectural, graphic design, art, sculpture, etc.
- AIA Las Vegas reserves the right not to award the advertised scholarship if it is determined by the committee that there are no qualified candidates.

Process of the Award:

- AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee and principals of SH ARCHITECTURE will evaluate the information provided on the scholarship application, and the essay.
- Compliance with selection criteria will be verified.
- Members from the AIA Scholarship Committee will review the application materials. Principals of SH ARCHITECTURE will make the final selection for the Award of Excellence recipient.

The Award funds will be administered through the UNLV Student Financial Services Office allowing the student to use the money for tuition, books, housing and other costs related to their architectural studies.
