THE JOEL BERGMAN, AIA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP, \$2,500

For students enrolled in 5th year studio in the fall of 2019 with concentration on Hospitality and Entertainment

CRITERIA

The AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee along with Bergman, Walls & Associates, Ltd. will offer one (1) scholarship for use in the 2019 Fall Semester at UNLV School of Architecture. This scholarship is in the amount of \$2,500.

The JOEL BERGMAN, AIA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is awarded to a student who demonstrates exceptional talent, desire and achievement with concentration on Hospitality and Entertainment.

Criteria for Selection:

- Architecture students currently enrolled in 4th year with full-time standing (12 credits) and entering 5th year M. Arch Program for the 2019 Fall semester at UNLV School of Architecture.
- Good academic standing with a minimum B-Grade point average (3.0 or higher cumulative GPA) is required for Design Studio Courses.
- Completion of the Spring 2019 Class project
- Candidates must provide a portfolio of projects evidencing design skills. The portfolio should provide examples of previous academic projects and/or personal work that can be architectural, graphic design, art, sculpture, etc.
- AIA Las Vegas and BWA reserve the right not to award this scholarship if it is determined by the committee that there are no qualified candidates.

Submission Instruction:

DO NOT COMBINE APPLICATIONS. Each Scholarship requires an individual application and **must be submitted separately from other applications.** Each one in an individual single PDF file containing one completed application form, the essay, if required, and all additional support materials.

The PDF file must be labeled as follows:

- YOUR NAME, NAME OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FOR WHICH YOU ARE APPLYING, AND THE YEAR. **For Example:** *Janie Doe / The Joel Bergman, AIA Memorial Scholarship 2019*

- **All submissions must be received by 5:00PM on Monday, April 22, 2019.**
- Complete application forms and digital portfolios should be sent to Randy Lavigne, Hon. AIA, Executive Director of the AIA Las Vegas Chapter, at rlavigne@aianeveda.org.
- AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee and principals of BWA will evaluate the information provided on the scholarship application and in the portfolio.
- Compliance with selection criteria will be verified.
- Members from the AIA Scholarship Committee will review the application materials. Principals of BWA will review each candidate application and portfolio and contact qualified candidates directly to arrange a personal interview prior to making the final selection of the scholarship recipient.

The Award funds will be administered through the UNLV Student Financial Services Office allowing the student to use the money for tuition, books, housing and other costs related to their architectural studies.
