## **THE WILLIAM SNYDER, FAIA HONORARY SCHOLARSHIP, \$1,000**

For students enrolled in 4th year studio in the fall of 2019

### **CRITERIA**

**The AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee along with William Snyder, FAIA, will offer one (1) scholarship for use in the 2019 Fall Semester at UNLV School of Architecture. This scholarship is in the amount of \$1,000.**

**The AIA Las Vegas Scholarship is awarded to a student who demonstrates a desire to achieve in the face of financial adversity.**

#### **Criteria for Selection:**

- Architecture students currently enrolled in 3rd year with full-time standing (12 credits) and entering 4th year for the 2019 Fall semester at UNLV School of Architecture.
- Good academic standing with a minimum B-Grade point average (3.0 or higher cumulative GPA) is required for Design Studio Courses.
- Completion of Spring 2019 Studio Project.
- Completion of the AIA Scholarship Application Form and a one-page statement of adversity to demonstrate how applicant is working toward academic achievement in the face of exceptional personal challenges.
- AIA Las Vegas reserves the right not to award the advertised scholarship if it is determined by the committee that there are no qualified candidates.

#### **Submission Instruction:**

**DO NOT COMBINE APPLICATIONS.** Each Scholarship requires an individual application and **must be submitted separately from other applications.** Each one in an individual single PDF file containing one completed application form, the essay, if required, and all additional support materials.

The PDF file must be labeled as follows:

- YOUR NAME, NAME OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FOR WHICH YOU ARE APPLYING, AND THE YEAR. **For Example:** *Janie Doe / The William Snyder, FAIA Honorary Scholarship 2019*

All submissions must be received by **5:00PM on Monday, April 22, 2019.**
