DETAILS

A prescribed burn will be conducted on the first available burn window between March 10-12, 2020. Participants should plan to attend the full day training. Attendees will experience a "start-to-finish" prescribed burn. Participants will have access all day to observe, ask questions and experience ignition and conducting a burn.

REQUIREMENTS

This event is a live fire demonstration. Participants will be expected to participate for the duration of the burn and to sign a hold-harmless liability disclosure/waiver on the day of the event. Participants must expect to be active all day walking, wearing proper attire and using/carrying tools.
