Eligibility of the award is open to any of alPHA's members, including medical officers of health, board of health members, members of Affiliate organizations and, occasionally, individuals outside the Association.

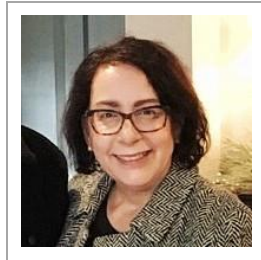

Teresa served as a provincial appointee for almost 10 years on the Board of Health of Perth District Health Unit. She was Board Chair for five years.

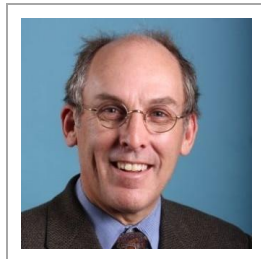
Sue Hochu, RDH
