


Where do I find my username?

- The “Forgot Password” feature will give you your username so long as you know and can access the email address on file for your account.
- Upon completing the “Forgot Password” process, you will be presented with your username on the last page. The process is as follows:
 1. Click on “[Click here to reset your password](#)”
 2. Enter your email address associated with your AMS account
 3. You will receive an email with a link “Reset My Password Now!” to reset your password.
 4. Follow the link and enter your new password (it can be the same password as before)
 5. Upon clicking the “Reset Password” button you will be presented with your username
