## **SENATE PASSES S993 GUN BAN / MAG BAN**

*Passes A2777 With Botched Amendments  
That Would Worsen Firearms Transportation Law*

*Both Bills Headed Back to Assembly For Concurrence*

This afternoon, the New Jersey Senate passed [S993](#) (gun ban / mag ban) on a partisan vote of 22-17. The Senate also passed [A2777](#) (reasonable deviations in firearms transportation) with a botched "fix" that would worsen firearms transportation law and further subject law abiding citizens to prison sentences of up to 10 years under New Jersey's tangled web of gun laws. A2777 passed on a partisan vote of 21-17.

As a result of Senate amendments to both bills, the legislation will need to return to the Assembly for concurrence, which could take place as soon as May 22<sup>nd</sup>.
