Applications are welcome from full-time faculty pursuing humanities research at colleges and universities in Maryland, Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and the District of Columbia.

Faculty from all ranks, including tenured, tenure-track, and non-tenured, may apply. Fellows will be in residence in the Dresher Center for the Humanities at UMBC for either one semester or one academic year in 2019–2020.

Benefits include a stipend for salary support and a grant for research expenses, as well as opportunities to participate in the Dresher Center's works-in-progress talks, public events, and other programs with UMBC faculty and other fellows.
