

## **Report from the chair of the APA's Committee for the Defense of Professional Rights of Philosophers**

During the last year the Defense Committee did not have any new cases presented to us. Instead, we fielded several queries and disposed of old business from the previous year. But just a week ago, the Defense Committee received a new case alleging procedural unfairness and discrimination on the grounds of race, gender, and national origin by a philosopher who was denied tenure. We have so far received over one hundred pages of text and one hundred and thirty documents related to this complaint. So, while we had a light load last year, the coming year looks likely to be very busy.
