Dear Amy,

Gaurav Vazirani mentioned that he was applying for a 2014 APA/PDC Prize for Excellence and Innovation in Philosophy Programs, and I'm writing now to support his application. I believe that his project, Wi-Phi: Open Access Philosophy (www.wi-phi.com), is innovative and has the potential to reach many students.

I met Gaurav Vazirani, the site's founder, several years ago when he and a fellow graduate student in philosophy from Yale University designed and implemented a philosophy program at a New Haven high school – a program that is still going strong.

Even then, Gaurav aspired to introduce many more students to philosophy than could be reached in any one school, or even in any city. I've been in touch with him for the past three years as he conceived of and refined his ideas for Wi-Phi. I'm also glad to say that the Squire Family Foundation is supporting his work. Our founder, Gary Squire, was extremely impressed with the thoroughness and scope of Gaurav's business plan.
