

Martha Nussbaum - singled out categories, beyond APA committees

1. Fostering and writing in new and controversial areas of philosophy: feminism, sexual orientation, disability, animal rights
2. Founding President of the Human Development and Capability Association, which aims to make philosophy central to the practice of development economics
3. Organizer of many philosophy conferences here and abroad. (Particularly, note the long series of conferences co-organized in Finland by Nussbaum and the late Juha Sihvola.)
4. Associate Editor of ETHICS for numerous years.
5. Represented Philosophy on the Membership Committee and the Council of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
6. Taught and supervised several generations of graduate students, and taught hundreds of undergrads and law students.
