### **Reimbursement of Relicensing Costs for U.S. Military Spouses**

The National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018 includes a provision for a member of the U.S. armed forces to be reimbursed for qualified relicensing costs of their spouse when the member is reassigned from a duty station in one state to a duty station in another state. The maximum reimbursement is \$500 per reassignment. The program is retroactive to December 12, 2017 and will expire December 31, 2022 unless it is extended by Congress.
