Dr. Jennifer Ibrahim is a tenured Associate Professor in the Department of Public Health, the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs for the College of Public Health, and the Associate Director of the National Program Office for Public Health Law Research. Jennifer has been recognized by her peers as an outstanding teacher, as evidenced by the award of all of Temple University's teaching awards, including the highest honor, the Great Teacher Award. In addition to her achievements in teaching and mentoring graduate students, she has maintained a funded research agenda in the area of health policy, including work on legal infrastructure, the dynamic relationship between public health lawyers and practitioners, and work on tobacco control policymaking. Jennifer earned a B.S. degree from Boston College in 1997, an M.P.H. from the University of Massachusetts Amherst in 1999 and a Ph.D. in Health Services and Policy Analysis and an M.A. in Political Science from the University of California, Berkeley in 2002. Dr. Ibrahim was the lead for the APTR Public Health Learning Modules project and managed the development of all 18 modules.
