

## **ASSISTANT or ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF Finance/Real Estate**

The School of Business at Portland State University seeks candidates for a full-time tenure-track faculty position in Finance/Real Estate beginning September 16, 2019. Qualified applicants should possess (1) a doctoral degree in business or related field with an emphasis in finance and real estate from an accredited institution (advanced ABDs will be considered but must have doctorate completed by August 30, 2019); (2) a promising research record (commensurate with the applicant's career stage) evidenced by publications in top-tier finance-related journals with research interests complementing those of existing Finance area faculty; and (3) a track record of recent, high-quality teaching, or demonstrated potential in teaching, in finance and/or real estate related areas.

Research interest in areas such as investments and real estate is a plus, and preference will be given to applicants who can demonstrate strong econometric skills within their research agenda.

Preference will also be given to candidates with teaching experience at the university level, especially at the graduate level. Teaching responsibilities include graduate courses in the Master of Real Estate Development Program, the Master of Finance Program, and undergraduate finance courses, both in-class and on-line. The position also comprises an expectation of school, university, professional, or community service relative to one's career stage. Salary is competitive and subject to applicant's qualifications.
