These programs provide environmental education activities that are approved by the AR Department of Education and AR Department of Human Services' Professional Development Registry (PDR) for 6 hours of professional development credit.

Each participant will receive 2 curriculum guides (a \$45 value) containing hundreds of hands-on interdisciplinary experiences for kids ages 3-7. Additional supplies, books, and resources will also be provided. All activities meet the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) criteria for curriculum and the Head Start Child Outcomes Framework.

Participants must stay for the full 6-hour training in order to receive the curriculum guides and 6 hours of professional development credit. Lunch will be provided. **Space is limited and registrations are a first-come, first-served basis. Please consider the \$20 registration as a commitment to attend.
