

**ORDER GOVERNING SPEEDY TRIAL ISSUES FOR CASES  
CONTINUED RESULTING FROM COVID-19**

THIS MATTER came before the Court *sua sponte* regarding criminal cases continued by the Court beginning March 13, 2020 pursuant to the Court's procedures relating to COVID-19.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, for any criminal case that has been continued by the Court since March 13, 2020 pursuant to the Court's procedures relating to COVID-19, where the continuance may impact a defendant's right to a speedy trial, the Commonwealth's Attorney and counsel for the Defendant shall forthwith place the case on the Court's docket as an emergency motion, which motion shall include the date Counsel believe said right shall expire. All such motions shall be filed with the Court not later than two (2) business days from the date of this Order; and it is further,


ORDERED, that all such other cases that may be continued by the Court from this date forward pursuant to the Court's procedures relating to COVID-19 where the continuance may impact a defendant's right to a speedy trial, the Commonwealth's Attorney and counsel for the Defendant shall forthwith place the case on the Court's docket as an emergency motion, with the information set forth above, no later than two (2) business days from the date the Court issues an order or memorandum continuing the case; and it is further,

ORDERED, the failure of defendant to comply with this Order may result in the Court finding the Defendant's right to a speedy trial has been waived.

ORDERED, that District 10 Probation and Parole, OAR and Defendants' counsel shall take all reasonable efforts to inform affected individuals of this Order, and a copy of this Order shall be provided by the Clerk of the Circuit Court to the office of District 10 Probation and Parole and the office of Offender Aid and Restoration located in Arlington County, Virginia.
