THIS MATTER came before the Court *sua sponte* regarding the possible impact of COVID-19 while citizens attend to matters in the Arlington County Courthouse.


ORDERED that effective May 22, 2020, until further Order of the Court, all persons who enter the Arlington County Courthouse shall have a United States Center for Disease Control recommended COVID-19 related mask covering his/her nose and mouth, without any markings facing outward other than an identifying mark pre-applied by a manufacture of a manufactured face mask; and it is further,


ORDERED, that should a person not have a mask the Arlington County Sheriff's Office will provide a mask, while the Court encourages everyone to bring their own mask; and it is further,


ORDERED that absent permission granted by a presiding judge, all persons in a courtroom shall maintain the face mask in place as ordered herein; and it is,
