In comparison to SSS14, there was one less exhibitor this year but there were also less expenses and registration was up with 17 attending MTM and 25in immunization training. The same amount of student handouts was pre-ordered. Next year’s date has been changed to 4/7/16 and there are already 3 interested sponsors for product theaters. Overall feedback from sponsors and attendees has been positive. One unexpected problem was a pre-populated form that was not planned for. Next year we hope to get the forms ahead of time so that the registration packets can be organized. S. Hattoy suggested budgeting for an extra projection cord so there is one available for each room next year and to have an AV person available during the first session. A needs assessment was also conducted to gather feedback on topics for next year. B. Esstman was welcomed to the BOD meeting.
