**TARGET AUDIENCE:** Designed for physicians, fellows, and residents

The practicing nephrologist needs knowledge of lung and basic cardiac ultrasound to help determine volume status, renal and bladder ultrasound to evaluate for structural abnormalities. This course will focus on the above elements in point of care ultrasonography. Image acquisition will be practiced on human models using high-quality ultrasound machines and supervised by experienced faculty. Training sessions give you practical, hands-on training.

### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- · Discuss how to perform lung and cardiac ultrasonography and ultrasonography of the renal system.
- · Identify appropriate uses of ultrasonography in renal practice.
