Question: What is the most commonly cited deficiency during ASHI lab inspections?

Answer: D.2.5.1 – *Laboratories must have a written agreement for histocompatibility testing with each transplant program or OPO they serve. Laboratories must review each agreement biennially and revise as necessary.*

The guidance for this standard has the 16 requirements for UNOS labs – often citations relate to one or two parts of this, but the whole standard has to be cited.
