MERLE W. HECKENLIVELY FOUNDER OF STANDARDS AWARD NOMINATION FORM

The “Merle W. Heckenlively Founder of Standards Award” for excellence in promoting the utilization of standards of ethics and practice thereof, within the construction industry. It is presented to an individual who has made significant contributions in developing and standardizing universal principals of ethics, integrity, values, and ideals, in creating standardization of methods of estimating into a “Standard Industry Practice.” Persons submitting a nomination must submit the Intent to Submit form by **March 15**. Award Nomination forms and narratives are due to the Society Business Office no later than **April 1**.

AWARD RESTRICTIONS & RULES

- a) Nominee has been an ASPE Member for a minimum of 3 years
- b) Nominee cannot be a Board of Directors Member
- c) Can only be awarded once for lifetime
- d) Fellows are not allowed to be nominated
- e) Individuals may submit for any or all Legacy Awards, however, may only receive one in an award year
- f) This award may not be awarded each year
- g) Nominee cannot hold a position on the National Standards Committee
