HOWARD S. PROUT FOUNDER OF CERTIFICATION AWARD NOMINATION FORM

The “Howard S. Prout Founder of Certification Award” recognizes an individual actively promoting and mentoring candidates through the Society’s CPE process. It is presented to an individual who has made significant contributions to certification by actively promoting the program through education about the program and serving as proctors and reviewer. Must also participate either locally or nationally to give feedback or guidance to further the program. Persons submitting a nomination must submit the Intent to Submit form by **March 15**. Award Nomination forms and narratives are due to the Society Business Office no later than **April 1**.

AWARD RESTRICTIONS & RULES

- a) Nominee has been an ASPE Member for a minimum of 5 years
- b) Nominee cannot be a Board of Directors Member
- c) Can only be awarded once for lifetime
- d) Fellows are not allowed to be nominated
- e) Individuals may submit for any or all Legacy Awards, however, may only receive one in an award year
- f) This award may not be awarded each year
- g) Nominee cannot hold a position on the National Certification Committee
- h) Nominee must hold the designation of Certified Professional Estimator
