## 2009-2017 Data Visualization



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# Executive Summary

AspireMN is an association of private agencies located throughout the state of Minnesota. AspireMN agencies provide an array of out-of-home and community-based services for children, adolescents, and families. While the Student Data Reporting System (SDRS) has been in operation since 1984, this report includes information on program participation between 2009 and 2017 from AspireMN member agencies. Data included in this report come from residential treatment centers, day treatment centers, treatment group homes, shelters, correctional programs, and treatment foster care programs.

Data used in this report are derived from all Intake forms, Discharge forms, Adult/Professional Satisfaction Surveys, and Youth Satisfaction surveys provided in 2009 through 2017, as well as all Follow-Up forms in which a follow-up interview was completed (i.e., those cases for which follow-up data were available). This report contains information on the number of programs participating (note that individual agencies may have multiple programs) and the number of program types participating each year over the nine-year period. This report also contains information about the number of children served by programs over the nine-year period. This report compares participation across the five types of SDRS data collection (intake, discharge, follow-up, adult/professional satisfaction surveys, and youth satisfaction surveys). It is important to note that SDRS forms are not linked across data collection time-points (intake, discharge, and follow-up).

The number of programs or agencies participating in SDRS has declined from 57 programs in 2009 to 35 programs in 2017. One possible explanation for the decline in programs participating over time is the closing of a substantial proportion of programs over the nine-year period (21 programs closed between 2009 and 2017, 26.9% of programs with a known service type). Further, the Student Data Reporting System has been undergoing updates during recent years, and some member organizations have chosen not to provide SDRS data during this transition. This transition may also explain the recent decline.

Despite the recent decline in participation, a substantial number of programs consistently participated over the nine-year period. For example, 25 programs provided SDRS data all nine years analyzed for this report (32.1% of those agencies or programs with a known service type), and 44 programs participated for six or more years (56.4% of those agencies or programs with a known service type). Furthermore, the number of day treatment programs has tripled over the nine-year period, the number of severe emotional disturbance residential treatment (SED RT) programs has remained stable during this time frame, and the number of treatment foster care programs participating has remained stable with the exception of one program that closed in 2010.

The average number of cases per year over the nine-year period varied by the type of data, with an average of 684 intakes, 640 discharges, 300 follow-up interviews, 387 adult satisfaction surveys, and 261 youth satisfaction surveys per year. The majority of data (including intake, discharge, follow-up, adult satisfaction, and youth satisfaction) were collected at residential treatment centers, which is the most common type of service provider among AspireMN member agencies participating in SDRS. Data from all member agencies provide a wealth of information on well-being for children and youth served at multiple time points, which

is not only unique in Minnesota (as most public systems collect minimal data on the well-being of children and youth they serve) but also on a national scale (as few entities across the United States harness data similar to that of AspireMN). While data are not linked at the child level, the consistent participation of multiple member agencies over time provides opportunities for longitudinal analyses highlighting trends over time. For all of these reasons, AspireMN's SDRS data is a powerful resource that can be harnessed to shape policy and practice across the state of Minnesota.

## Patterns in Program Participation over Time (2009-2017)

While SDRS has been in operation since 1984, this report focuses on program participation between 2009 and 2017. Figure 1 depicts the number of known programs providing SDRS data between 2009 and 2017. The number of programs providing SDRS data was greatest in 2009 (n = 57), while the fewest programs reported SDRS data in 2017 (n = 35).

*Number of Known Programs Participating by Year (2009-2017)*

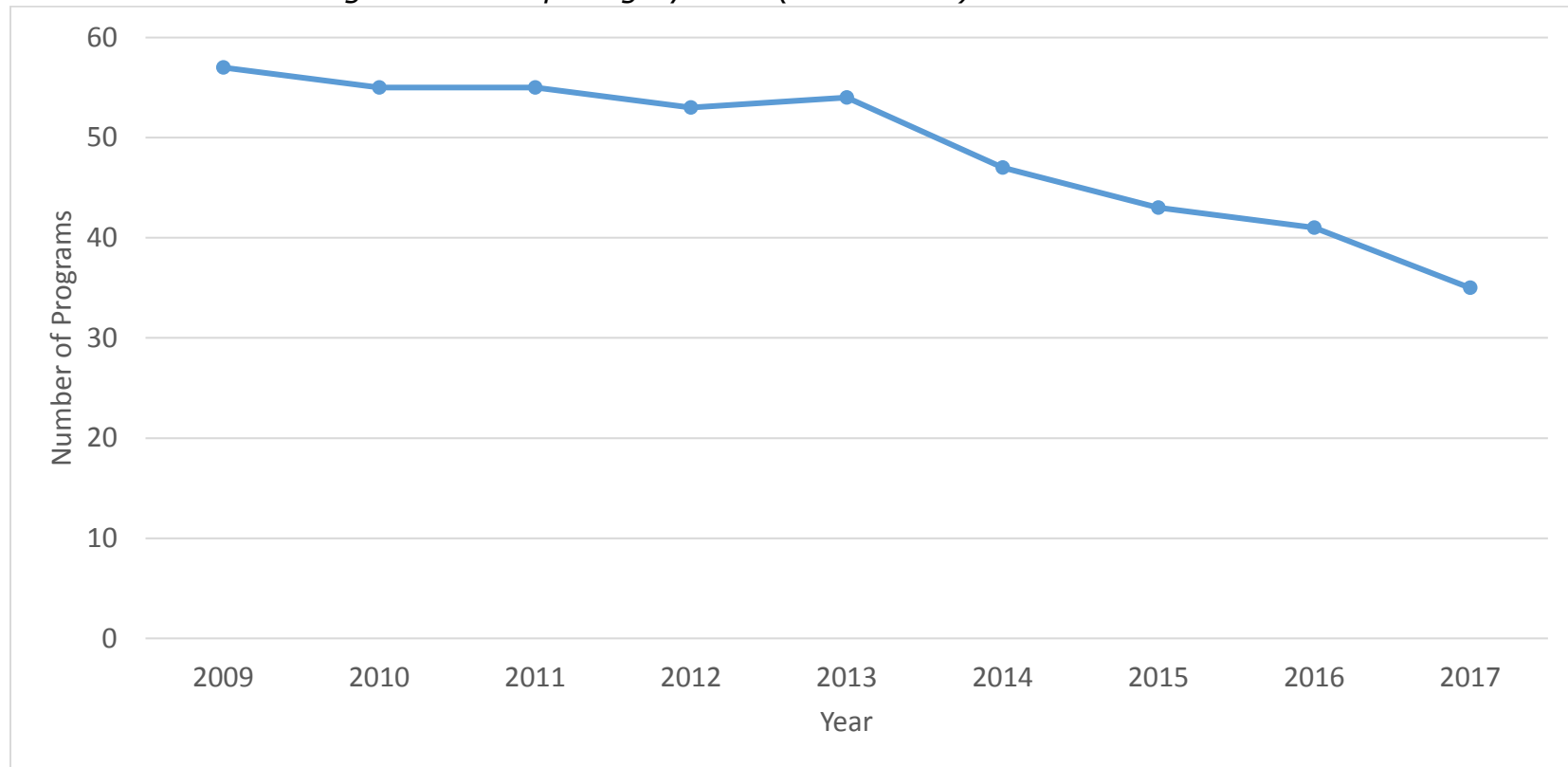


Table 1 provides the specific number of known programs for each year, as well as providing information on the numbers of programs that were excluded from analysis. Note that those programs listed as “excluded” were excluded from analyses for one of two reasons: (1) because their corresponding program numbers were not identifiable (i.e., data input errors that could not be corrected), or (2) because the types of services provided were not able to be determined because the given program number corresponded to an agency providing multiple types of services through different programs.

Table 2 illustrates the years in which specific programs provided SDRS data. Programs are organized into categories based on the type of services provided, including unknown programs that were excluded from analyses. The final column in this table indicates the total number of years in which a program participated. It is important to note that of the 78 known programs, approximately 32% of programs participated all nine years (n = 25), and over half of the known programs provided SDRS data six or more years (n = 44).

Figure 2 portrays the changes in program participation by program type between 2009 and 2017. While the overall number of known programs has declined from 57 in 2009 to 35 in 2017, the number of day treatment programs providing data for SDRS has tripled between 2009 and 2017, and the number of severe emotional disturbance residential treatment (SED RT) programs has remained the same during this time frame. Table 3 includes the specific numbers of programs of all types participating in each year used to construct Figure 2.

*Program Participation by Program Type over Time (2009-2017)*

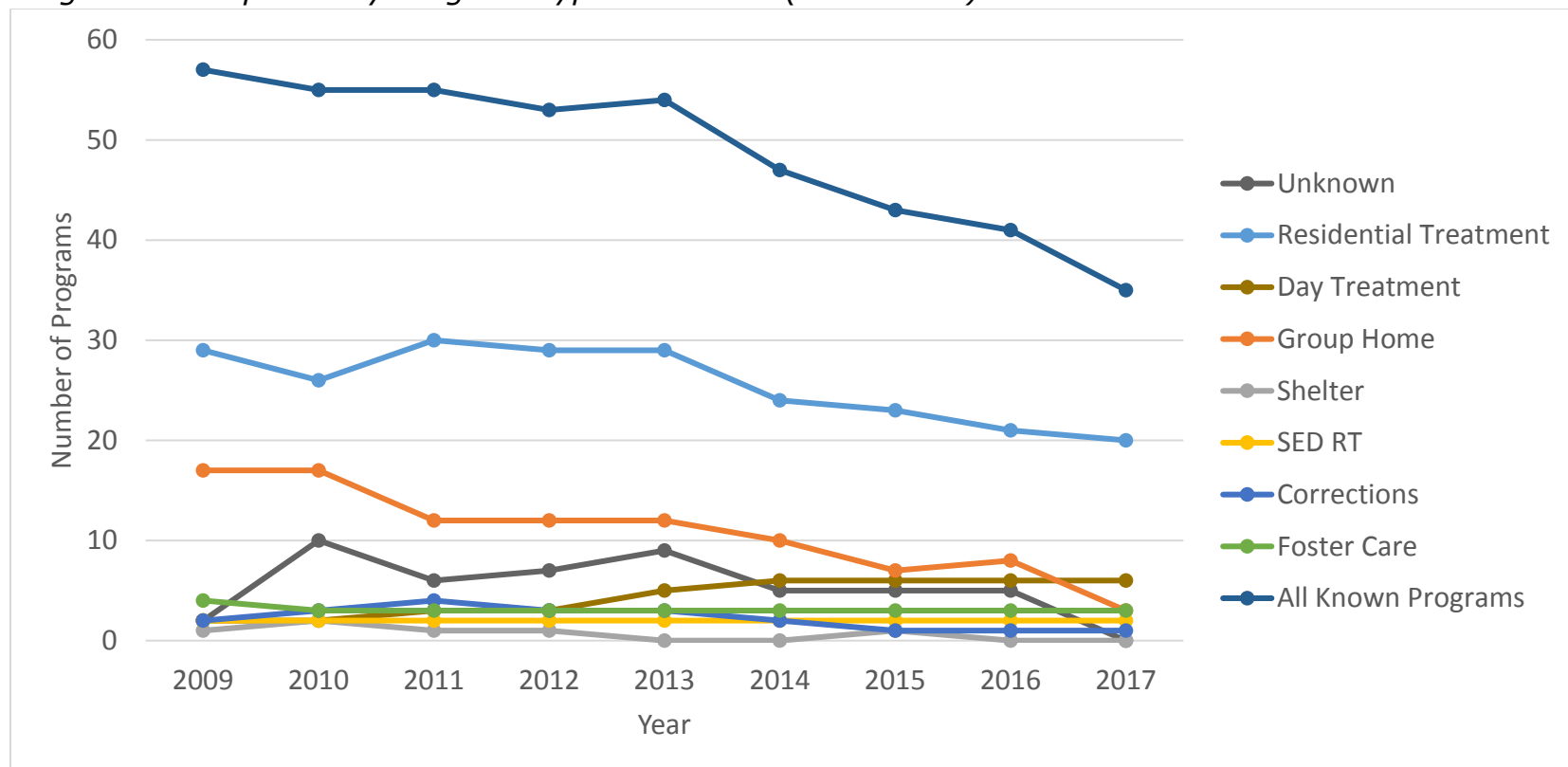

## Intake Data over Time (2009-2017)

*Intakes by Program Type over Time (2009-2017)*

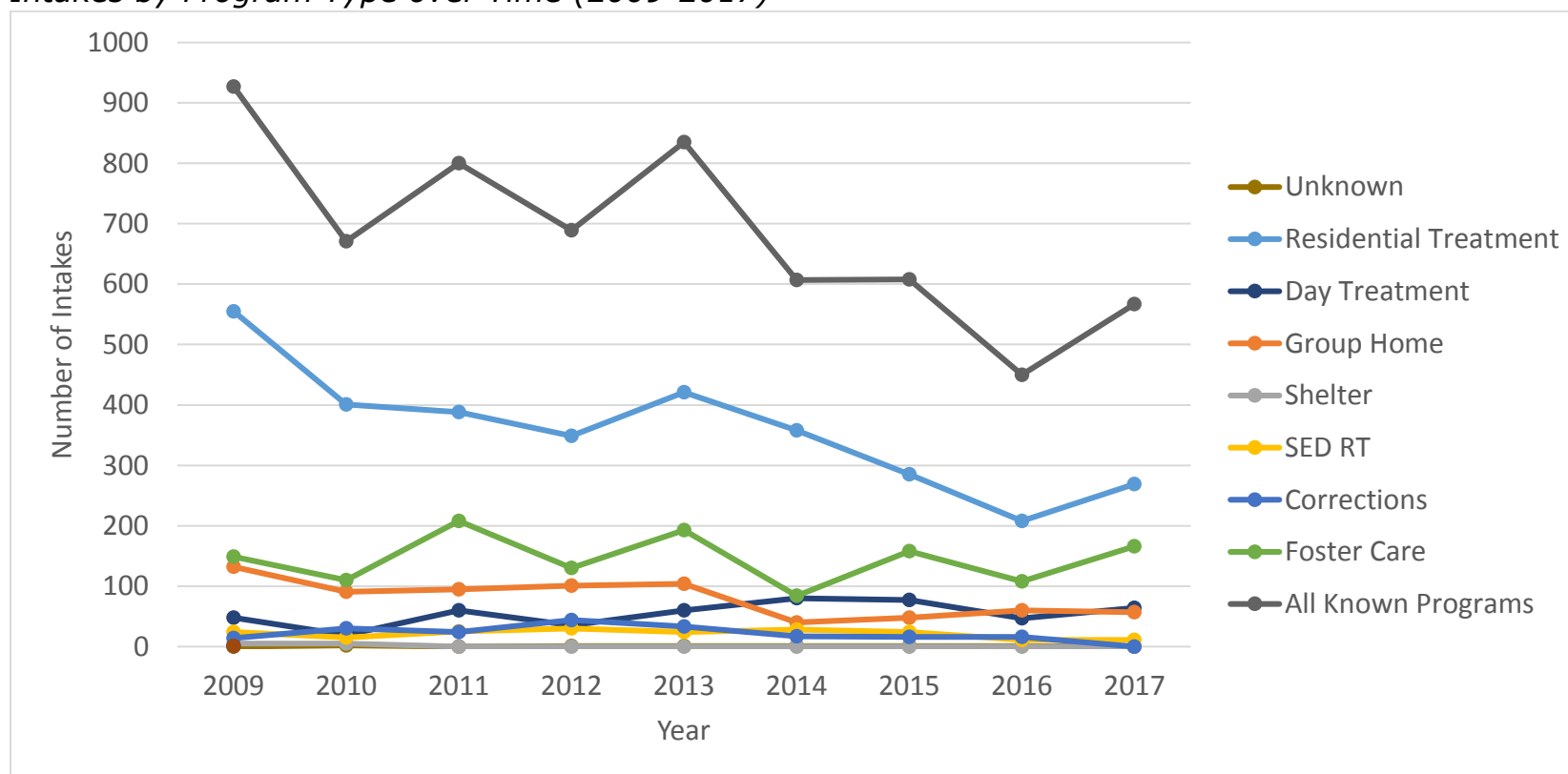

## Discharge Data over Time (2009-2017)

*Discharges by Program Type over Time (2009-2017)*

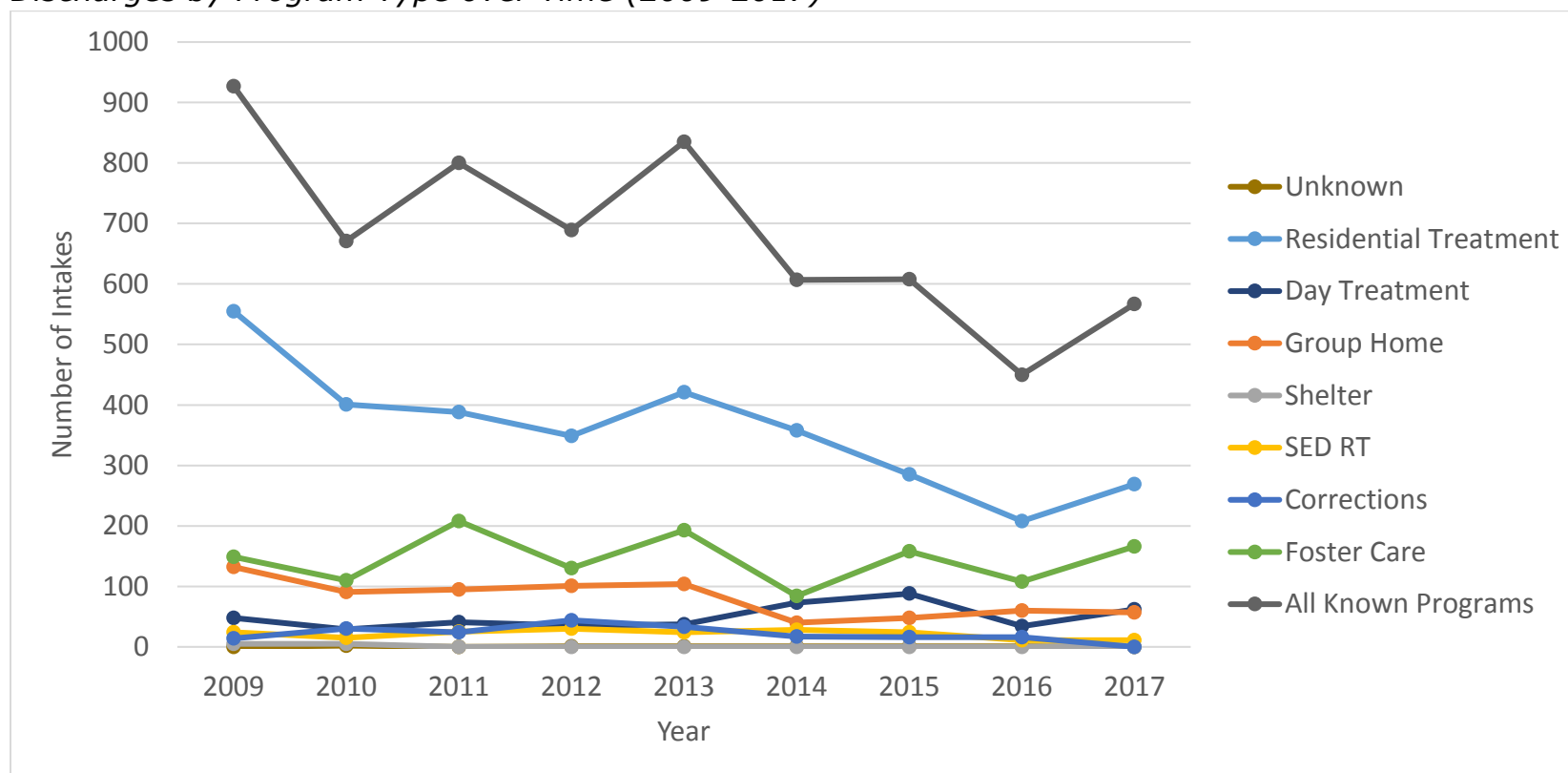

## Follow-Up Data over Time (2009-2017)

Figure 5 illustrates the number of six-month follow-up interviews that were completed during each calendar year. More follow-up interviews were completed in 2009 than in any other year (n = 435), while the fewest follow-up interviews were completed in 2017 (n = 174). *Completed Follow-Ups by Program Type over Time (2009-2017)*

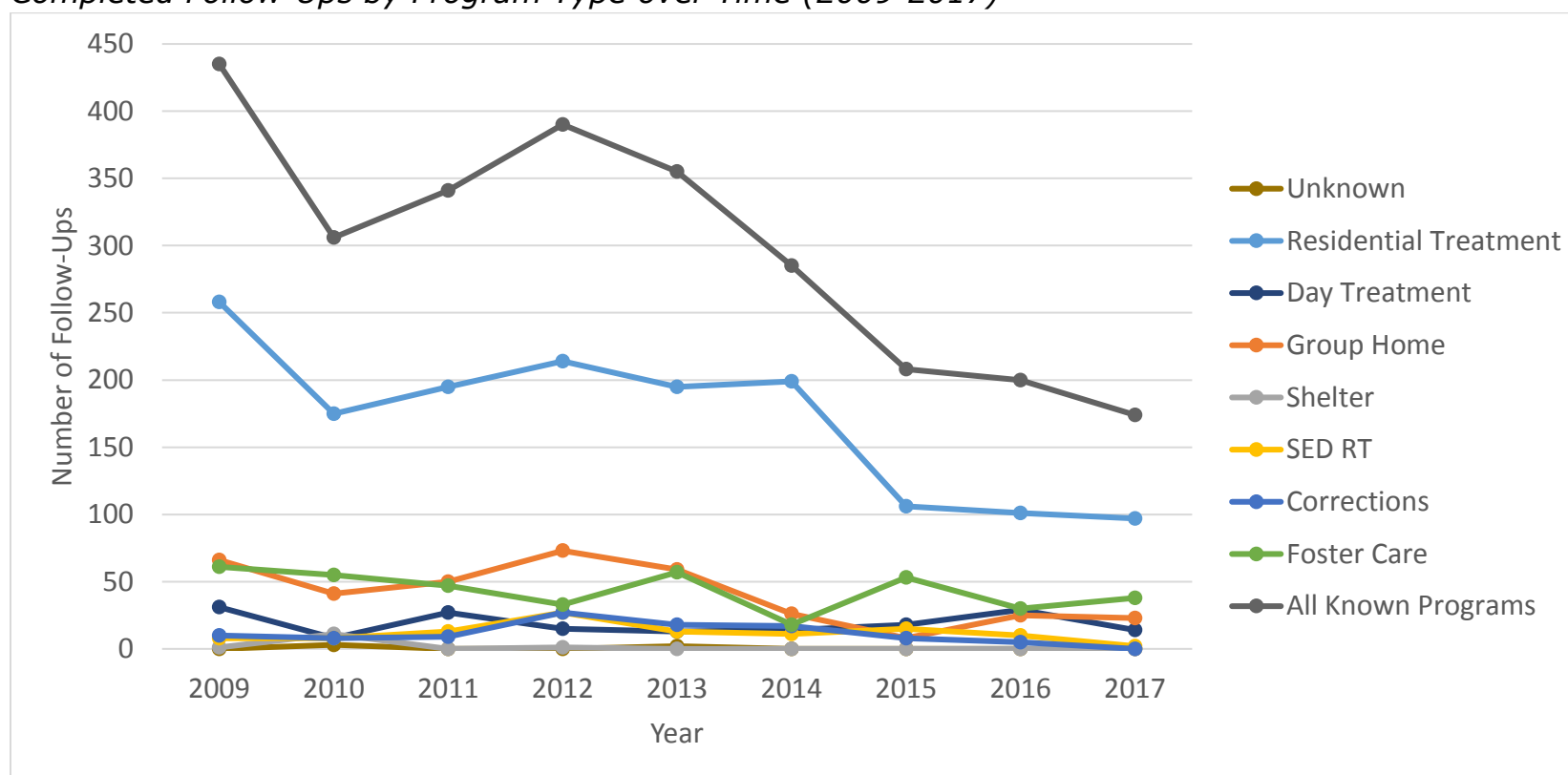

## Adult Satisfaction Survey Data over Time (2009-2017)

The number of adult/professional satisfaction surveys for each year (i.e., those surveys with a corresponding discharge date that fell within each calendar year) is depicted in Figure 6. The number of adult satisfaction surveys was greatest in 2009 (n = 519) and smallest in 2017 (n = 66). Table 7 contains specific information regarding the number of adult satisfaction surveys for each year by program type.

*Adult/Professional Satisfaction Surveys by Program Type over Time (2009-2017)*

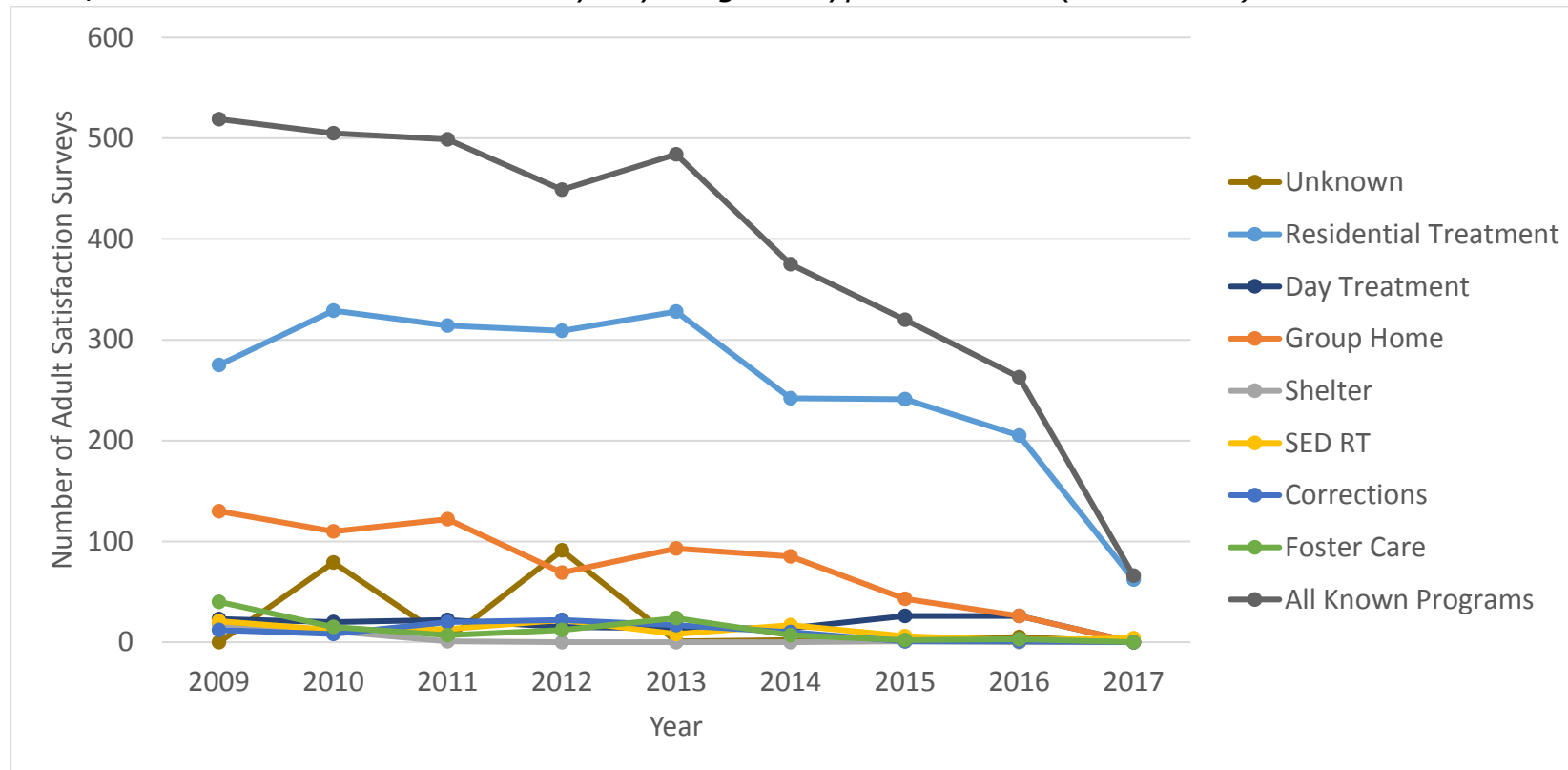

## Youth Satisfaction Survey Data over Time (2009-2017)

Figure 7 illustrates the number of youth satisfaction surveys for each year (i.e., those surveys with a corresponding discharge date that fell within each calendar year). More youth satisfaction surveys were completed in 2012 than in any other year (n = 344), while the fewest youth satisfaction surveys were completed in 2017 (n = 97). *Youth Satisfaction Surveys by Program Type over Time (2009-2017)*

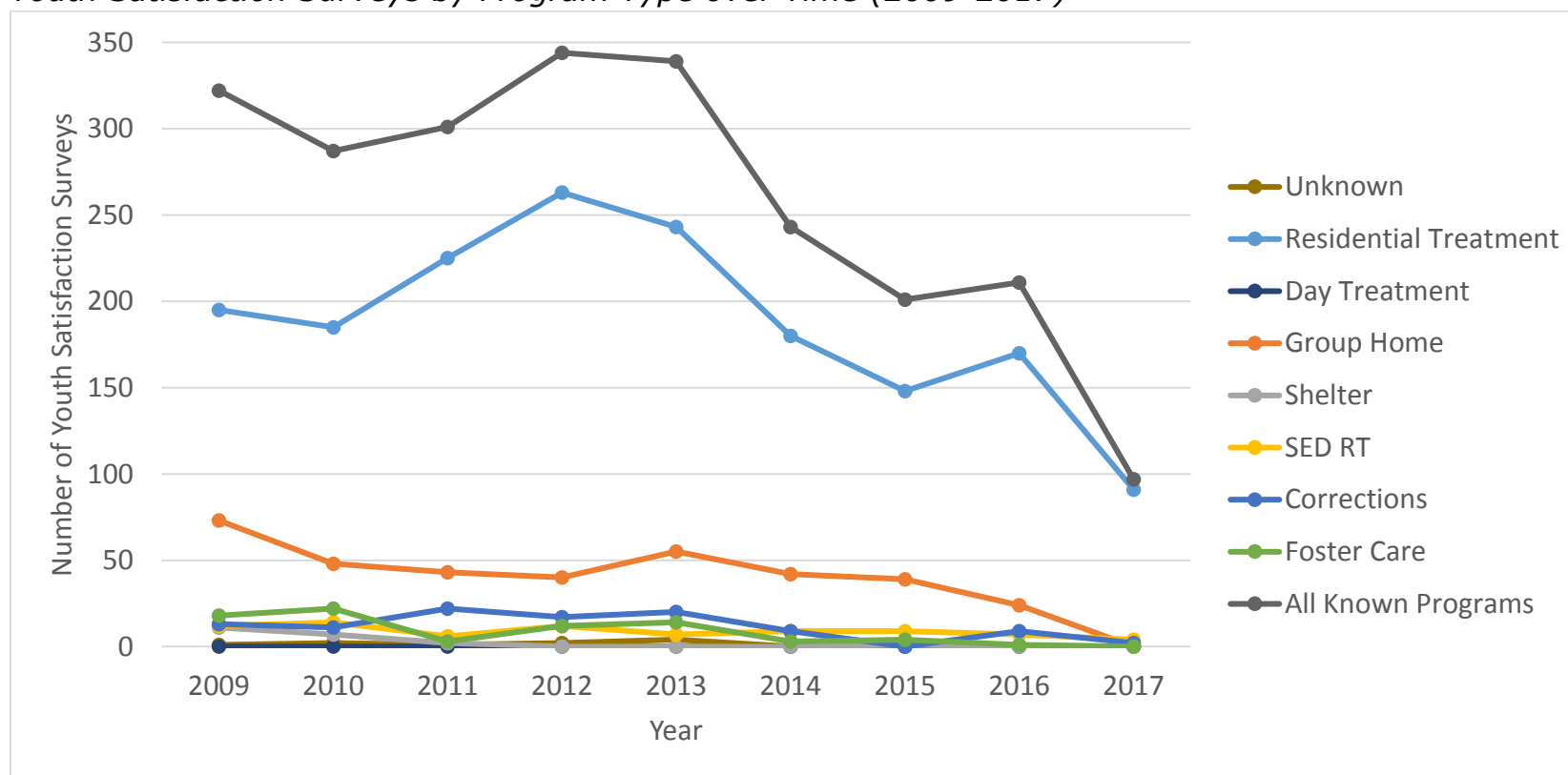
