

ASM Scholarship Program 2018 Application Rules and Guidelines

The College Scholarship Program of the Associated Subcontractors of Massachusetts (ASM) has been established to serve as a benefit to ASM Member Companies and their employees. The Scholarship Program is supported by the proceeds of the annual ASM Golf Tournament.

Five scholarships each in the sum of **\$2,000** will be awarded to students who are enrolled in an accredited college or university. Preference will be given to entering freshmen; however anyone attending an accredited college or university may apply.

General Scholarship Parameters:

- 1. Applicants must be an accepted freshman or returning student at an accredited college or university (undergraduate only).
- 2. Applicants must be employed fulltime for a minimum of 2 consecutive years by an ASM Member Company, or be an immediate family member (spouse/child) of such fulltime employees.
- 3. Applicants must have an above average cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average), i.e. the equivalent of a 3.0 or greater average on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Applicants must intend to carry a full academic load during the scholarship period.
- 5. Applicants may reapply each year, but may only receive one scholarship award.
- 6. Each ASM Member Company can submit up to 5 applications per year.

Awarding Guidelines:

Applications are received first by the ASM Scholarship Committee who will assign points based on the point system outlined below. The Committee will identify the top ten candidates to the Executive Committee of the ASM Board of Directors. The Executive Committee members will review the applications on a "blind" basis, i.e. with personally identifiable information removed from the review packet, and will make the final selection. Prior to receiving the scholarship award, the recipient must show he/she has enrolled in the college or university for the scholarship term.

Judging Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed on a point system, with 100 points being the maximum. The number of points will be assigned based on the following criteria:

- 1. **Total of 40 points.** Applicants will be judged by their cumulative grade point average (GPA). A perfect 4.0 would receive 40 points. Applications with a GPA under the required average of 3.0 will be disqualified.
- 2. Total 30 points. Applicants will be judged on their achievements/citizenship
 - School sponsored or related activities: 10 points
 - Community Service: 10 points
 - Achievements (including education, work experience, sports, music, hobbies, leadership, etc.): 10
 points
- 3. **Total 30 points.** Applicants will submit a written essay of not more than 350 words describing what their college education means to them and what their aspirations are for the future, including career plans, community involvement and other goals.

How to Apply:

Applications are now available and must be submitted **no later than April 1, 2018**. Award recipients will be notified by May 30, 2018 and are expected to be present at the ASM annual Golf Tournament dinner to receive the award.

 - 2. Community service
 - 3. Achievements (including education, work experience, sports, music, hobbies, leadership, etc.)
 - *Note: If you are now in college, also include information on your activities during high school.
