



College/University Scholarship Program 2022 Rules and Guidelines

The College/University Scholarship Program of the Associated Subcontractors of Massachusetts, Inc. (ASM) has been established to serve as a benefit to ASM Member companies and their employees. The Scholarship Program is supported by proceeds from the annual ASM Golf Tournament.

Four \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in an accredited 2- or 4-year public or private college or university for undergraduate studies only, not for graduate studies. Preference will be given to entering freshmen; however, anyone attending an accredited college or university may apply.

General Scholarship Parameters:

1. Applicants must be accepted at an accredited 2- or 4-year public or private college or university (undergraduate only)
2. Applicants must be employed fulltime for a minimum of two consecutive years by an ASM Member company, or be an immediate family member (spouse/child) of such fulltime employees
3. Applicants must have an above average cumulative GPA (equivalent of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale)
4. Applicants must intend to carry a full academic class schedule during the scholarship period
5. Applicants may reapply each year but may only receive one scholarship award
6. Each ASM Member company can submit up to five applications per year

Awarding Guidelines:

Applications are reviewed by the ASM Scholarship Committee, who assign points based on the judging criteria below. The top 10 candidates are referred to the ASM Board of Directors Executive Committee, who review the applications on a “blind” basis (personally identifiable information removed), and make final selections. Prior to receiving the scholarship award, the recipient must show (s)he has enrolled in an accredited 2- or 4-year public or private college or university for the scholarship term.

Judging Criteria:

Applications are reviewed on a point system, with 100 points maximum, based on the following criteria:

1. **Total of 40 points.** Applicants will be judged by their cumulative GPA (*e.g.*, a 4.0 receives 40 points). Applications with a GPA under the required average of 3.0 will be disqualified.
2. **Total 30 points.** Applicants will be judged on their achievements/citizenship
 - School sponsored or related activities
 - Community Service
 - Achievements (*e.g.*, education, work experience, sports, music, hobbies, leadership)
3. **Total 30 points.** Applicants will submit a written essay between 300 and 500 words in length describing what their college education means to them and what their aspirations are for the future, including career plans, community involvement and other goals.

How to Apply:

Applications must be submitted **no later than April 1, 2022**. Award recipients will be notified by June 1, 2022 and are expected to be present at the ASM Annual Golf Tournament Dinner, July 14, 2022, to receive the award.
